***The CJ plenary for October will again be a forum, this time addressing Latino mental health.*** The forum is not only for mental health providers but for all service providers who work with the Latino community. A local bilingual mental health practitioner from the FOCUS Women's Center, Dr. Heather Finkel, will also present.
