Supply Update

Kinrix is currently unavailable in both presentations. Resupply is not expected until at least mid-July. For the time being, please order

your DTaP and IPV vaccines in alternate formulations.

Limited supply of Infanrix syringes are available. Orders placed for syringes will be filled with vials once supply is depleted. Resupply is expected mid-July.

ProQuad is not currently available through the VFC program and is not expected to be available for the remainder of 2011.

Minor changes were made in these VISs to reflect the approval of quadrivalent HPV for prevention of anal cancer. Recommendations for the vaccines' use have not changed, and while use of the most recent VIS is always desirable, providers may use up stock of existing HPV VISs.

2010-2011 Influenza Vaccine

All 2010-2011 intranasal vaccine has expired, and injectable vaccine will expire June 30, 2011. As per ACIP recommendation, please continue to vaccinate throughout the flu season. Expired flu vaccine should be returned to McKesson as with other VFC vaccine. Viable vaccine may not be returned.
