**Subject: Rabid Fox in Chesapeake**

On May 4, 2011 a fox was found in the 3200 block of Western Branch Blvd., in Chesapeake. The fox was involved with a visitor traveling through the area. The fox was killed and tested positive for rabies. The exposed visitor is currently receiving rabies prophylaxis

If you have a wild animal on your property, contact Virginia Dept. of Game and Inland Fisheries (DGIF) at (804-829-6580), after hours and weekends call (804-367-1258). If you have a sick or injured wild animal on your property, contact Chesapeake Police Dispatch (757-382-6161).

This is the 81st confirmed case of rabies in Chesapeake since 1988 (3 cats, 2 bats, 59 raccoons & 16 foxes).
