

Chickahominy Health District Food Safety Courses 2009

The Chickahominy Health District which includes the counties of Charles City, Goochland, Hanover and New Kent will offer the following food safety classes and examination dates during 2009.

Cooking For a Crowd: *This class is offered upon request and will be taught at the requesting facility.* A basic food safety class covering the safe preparation and service of food. Primarily intended for church groups, social, service or other organizations and individuals interested in providing safe food to a crowd in a non public setting. Class time is approximately 3 hours. A certificate of completion will be given upon passage of a course test. Cost: \$15.00 per person, includes training materials. Minimum class size: 10.

ServSafe Certification Course: An advanced class in food safety principles for management and supervisory level personnel who want to be nationally certified in food safety by the National Restaurant Association Education Foundation. This class will prepare persons in charge of food establishments to demonstrate knowledge in risk factors and food safety principles as required by the Virginia Food Regulations. Class time is approximately 12 hours over 1.5 days which includes review time and administration of the examination. *This is a fast-paced class. Attendees are responsible for ordering the textbook. It is strongly encouraged that text books be ordered several weeks prior to the class and that attendees study the material prior to attending the class. Text books can be ordered online from the National Restaurant Association at www.servsafe.com/catalog/productlist.aspx?SCID=5&RCID=1. Order text book ESX5 with exam answer sheet. The cost is \$69.30.* A nationally recognized certificate will be awarded upon passage of the course test. This certificate is valid for 5 years. Cost: \$130.00 per person. Minimum class size: 10.

Temporary Food Establishment Food Safety Class: A basic food safety class for persons who prepare and serve food at public events. Intended audiences include members of churches, school booster clubs/athletic associations, rescue/fire squads, fraternal/social organizations, non profit groups, individuals, etc. who would require an inspection and a temporary food establishment permit to operate at a public event. Class time is approximately 3 hours. A certificate of completion will be given upon passage of a course test. It is recommended that at least two members of an organization attend. This certificate is valid for 3 years. Successful completion of the class will allow an organization to begin preparing and serving food at public events prior to a health department inspection. Cost: \$20.00 per person, includes training materials. Minimum class size: 10.

Proctored ServSafe Certification Examination Dates: *This is an examination administration only* for individuals who wish to study on their own time and take the ServSafe Certification Course Examination given by a registered ServSafe Proctor. *There will be no review time on the exam day. Only the exam will be given.* Individuals are responsible for ordering the text book, either the ServSafe Essential or ServSafe Coursebook 5th Edition with the examination answer sheet from the National Restaurant Association at www.servsafe.com/catalog/productlist.aspx?SCID=5&RCID=1. Examination test booklets will be ordered by the class proctor. A nationally recognized certificate will be awarded upon passage of the course test. This certificate is valid for 5 years. Cost: \$40.00 per person, includes examination book.

ServSafe Employee Course: *This class is offered upon request and will be taught for five or more employees at the requesting facility.* This is an introductory class in food safety for persons employed in a food establishment including cooks, dishwashers, wait staff, etc. It will provide employees with basic principles in food safety such as personal hygiene, cross contamination, cooking/holding temperatures, food storage and cleaning and sanitizing equipment. Class time is approximately 3-4 hours. A certificate of completion will be awarded upon passage of a course test. Cost: \$5.00 per person, includes course book and additional handouts.
