

## General Changes

- Updates terminology throughout the *Code of Virginia* to ensure consistent usage of terms referring to entities involved in the delivery of emergency medical services, including to "emergency medical services," "emergency medical services system," "emergency medical services agency," "emergency medical services provider," "emergency medical services personnel," and "emergency medical services vehicle." These terms are defined in § 32.1-111.1.
- Clarifies difference between "emergency medical services personnel" and "emergency medical services provider." These terms are defined in § 32.1-111.1.
- Separates provisions governing organization and operation of fire departments and fire companies and delivery of fire services from provisions governing organization and operation of emergency medical services agencies and delivery of emergency medical services. These changes, affecting primarily Chapter 2 of Title 27 and Article 2.1 of Chapter 4 of Title 32.1, were made because fire services and emergency medical services are governed by two separate agencies, and while many of the provisions are similar, it is necessary to clearly spell out the requirements for each type of service. Many provisions found in Chapter 2 of Title 27 have been duplicated, with appropriate amendments, in Article 2.1 of Chapter 4 of Title 32.1.
- Reorganizes portions of both Chapter 2 of Title 27 and Article 2.1 of Chapter 4 of Title 32.1, for clarity.
- Makes editorial changes to reflect current drafting style throughout.
