## Virginia OEMS approves ProCPR

(Blended course only)

Beginning January 1, 2008, the Virginia Office of EMS has approved the ProCPR Certification, both initial and recertification, as meeting the requirements for Basic Life Support certification course enrollment and state certification testing.

This approval is for the blended course only. The blended course allows the student to complete the didactic portion of the course on-line, but requires them to schedule their practical test with certified CPR Instructor/Skill Evaluator. Upon successful completion of the didactic portion, the student will print a temporary card and meet with certified CPR Instructor/Skill Evaluator to perform the practical portion. Upon successful skill demonstration, the Skill Evaluator will sign the temporary card and fax a completed checklist to ProCPR. A permanent card will then be sent to the student bearing the digital signature of the Skill Evaluator. **Temporary Cards will not be accepted as evidence of successful completion. The student must have a permanent card issued by ProCPR.**

### ProCPR SAMPLE BLENDED COURSE CERTIFICATION CARD

*Permanent Card: Sent by mail. Includes digital signature of the skill evaluator.*

Once a faxed copy of the completed checklist from the skill evaluator is received, a permanent card with the skill evaluator's digital signature is mailed. The permanent copy has a sticky back that folds in half making a wallet sized card with a durable matt laminated surface.
