


World TB Day March 24, 2015

On World TB Day we recognize the partnerships at the local, state, national and global levels that make it possible to reach those at highest risk for TB, and to identify and implement innovative strategies to fight TB.


TB Globally

- In 2013, there were an estimated 9 million new cases of TB
- An estimated 1.5 million deaths occurred in 2012, including 360,000 that were associated with HIV
- Globally in 2013, MDR-TB was seen in nearly 315,000 cases




TB in the United States

- In 2014, the United States reported 9,412 TB cases for a rate of 3.0/100,000
- Compared to 2013 this represents a decrease of 1.6% in the number of cases and a 1.6% decrease in the rate



TB in Virginia

- Virginia reported 198 cases in 2014 for a rate of 2.4/100,000
- Compared to 2013 this represents a 10.6% increase in the number of cases and a 9.9% increase in the rate
- Most of the increase in 2014 occurred among US born people with 51 cases reported compared to 31 cases in 2013
