Figure 6. Chlamydia cases, 2005-2009

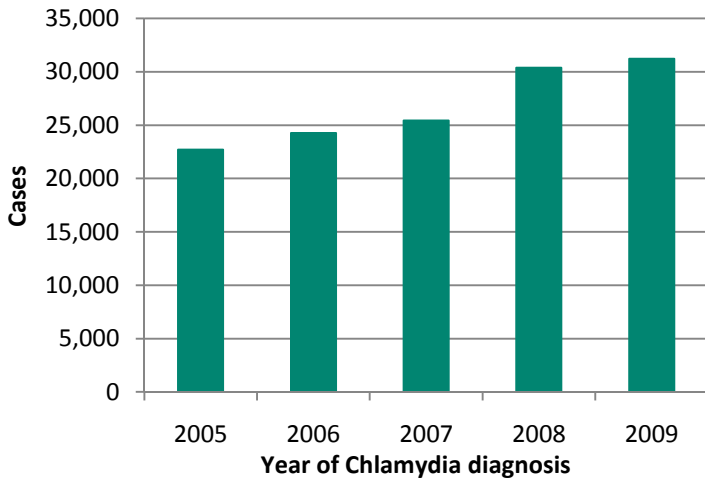
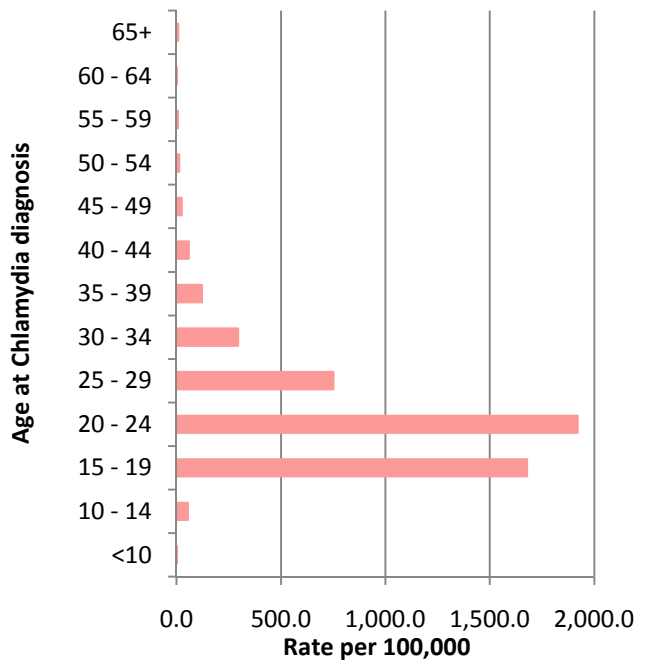


Figure 7. Rate of Chlamydia by age group, 2005-2009
