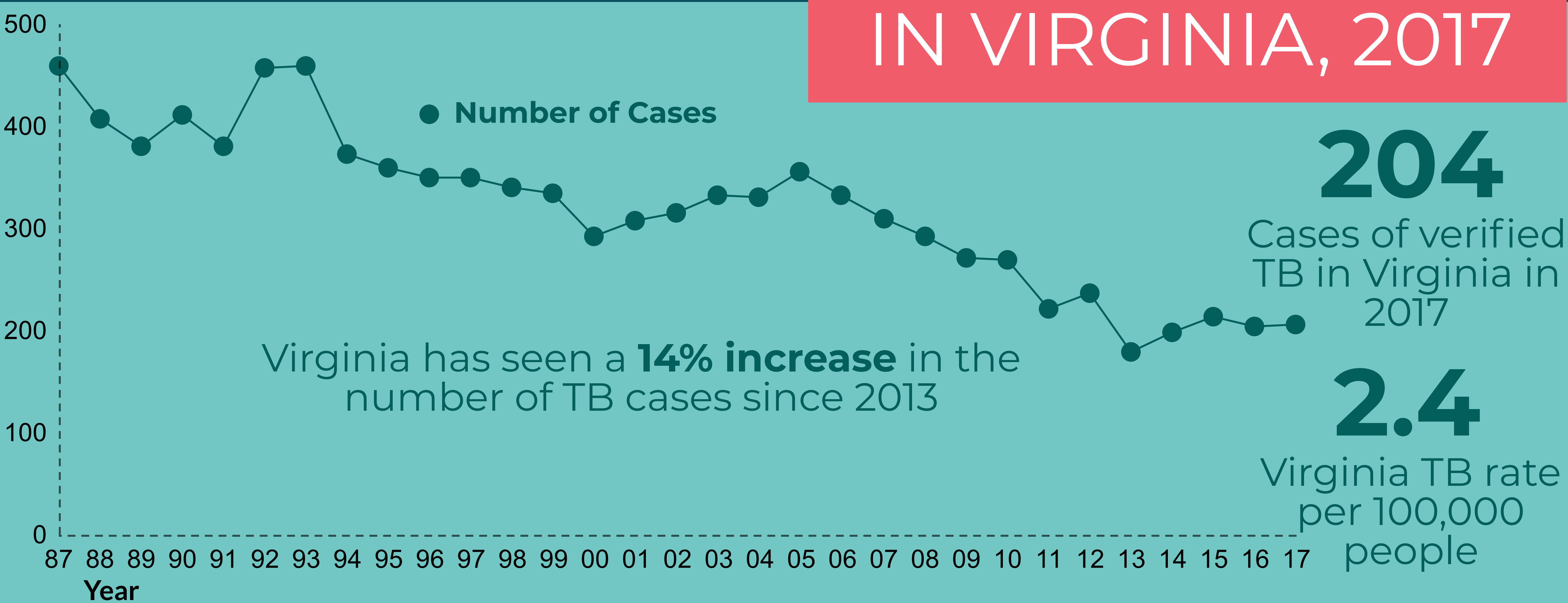

MOST COMMON COUNTRIES OF BIRTH AMONG PATIENTS



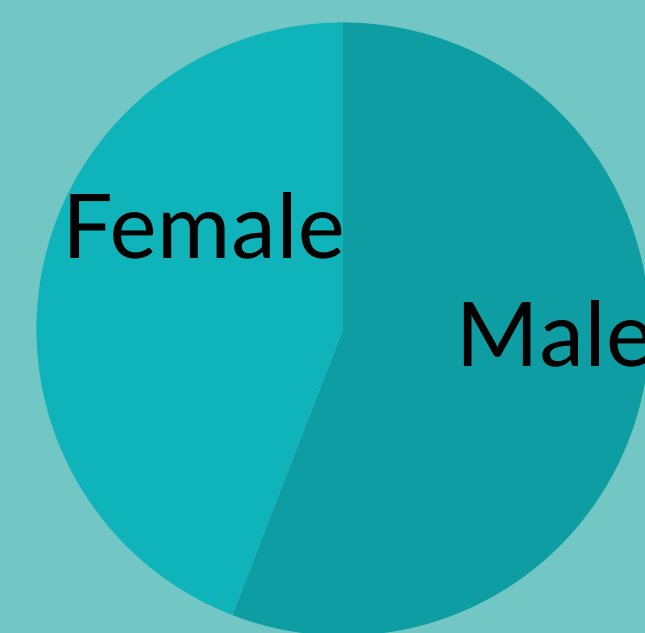

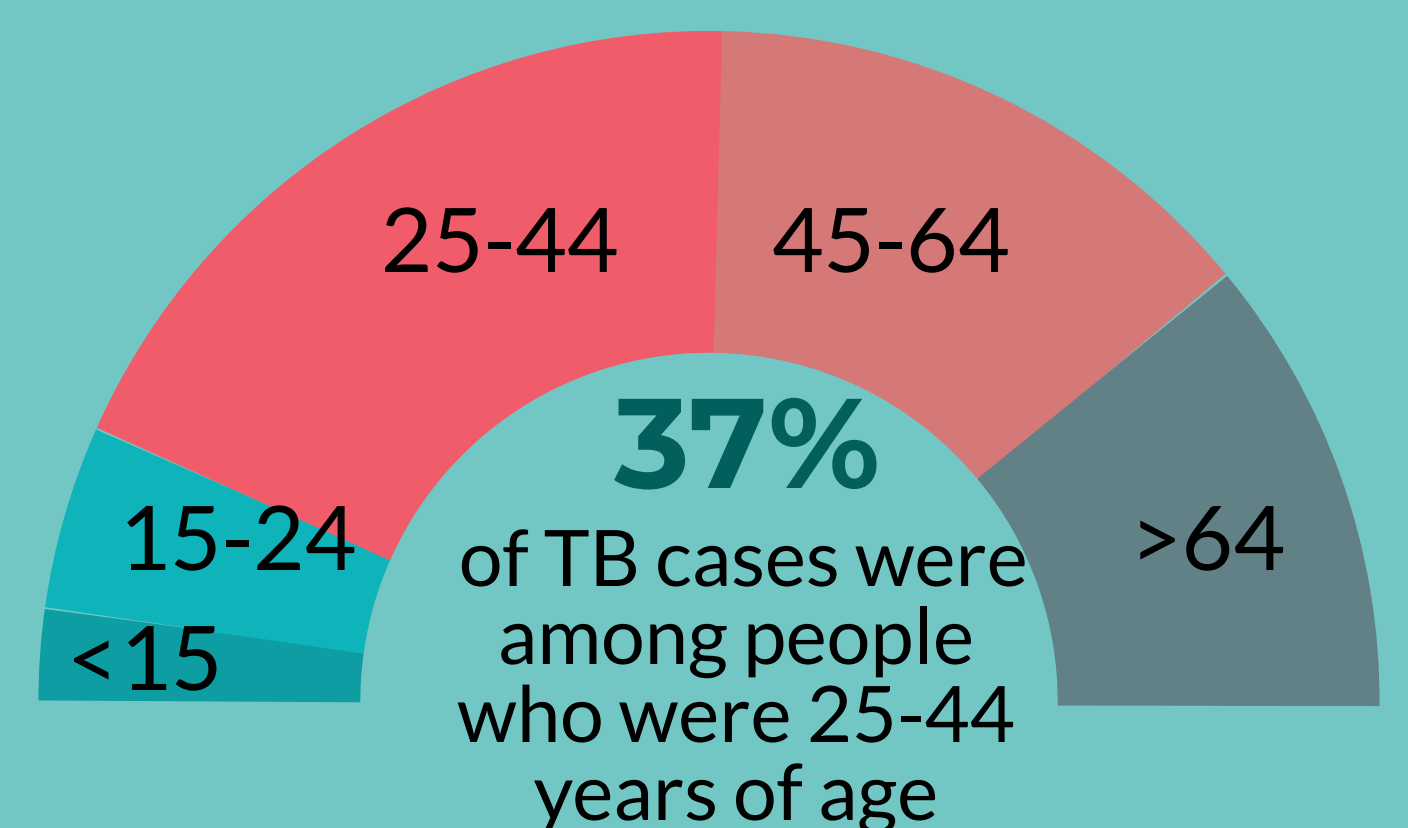
Median number of years in the U.S. at time of diagnosis among Non-U.S.-born patients

DEMOGRAPHIC CHARACTERISTICS



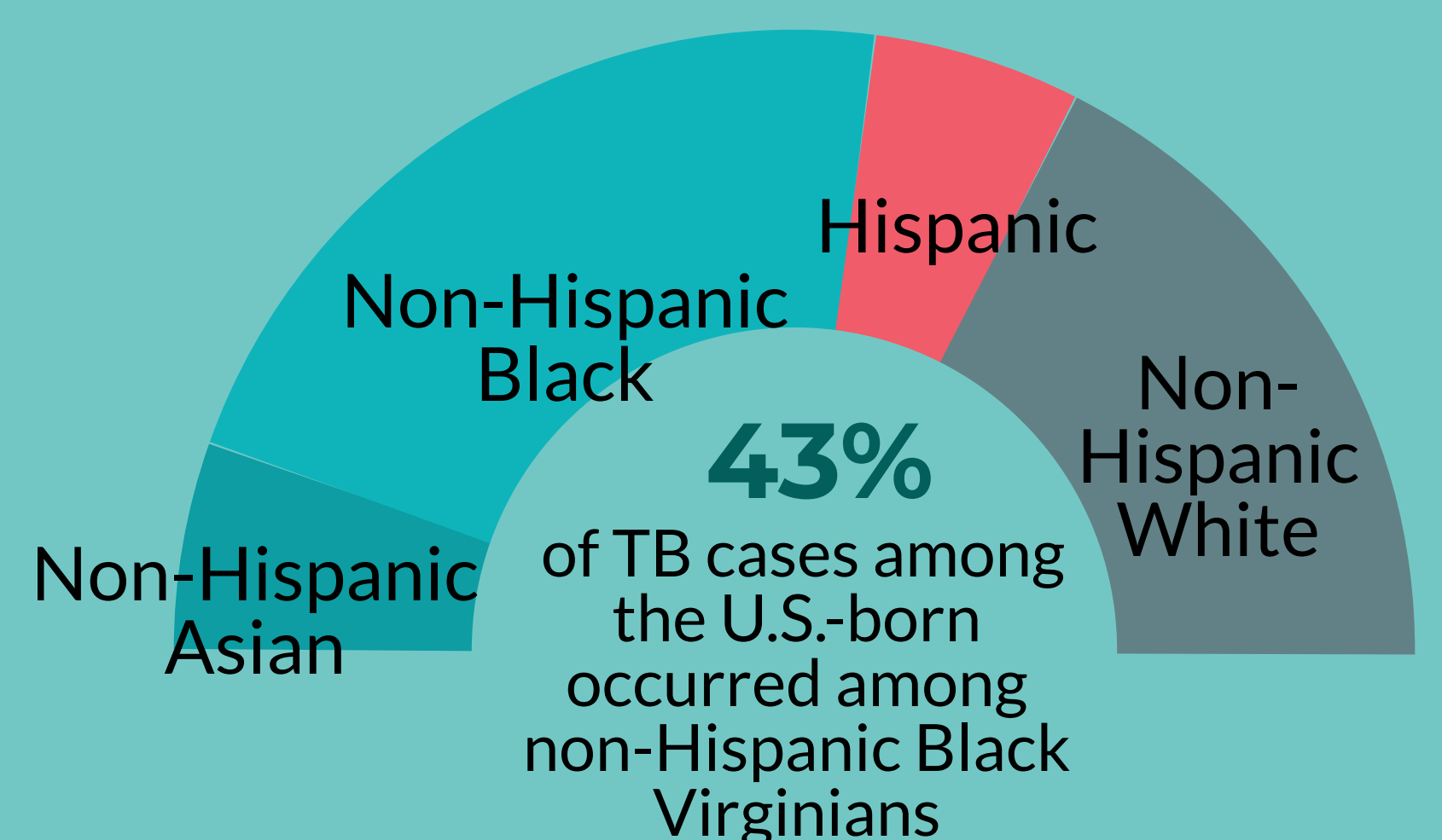
