Rabies vaccines for dogs, puppies, cats and kittens will be available for a, **CASH ONLY**, fee of \$10.00.

Dr. Kristine Jones of The Animal Medical Center of Louisa will be conducting the clinic from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. The Veterinarian urges all pet owners to take advantage of the clinic.

The County is emphasizing the vaccination of all dogs and cats. **If dogs and cats have been vaccinated within the past three years, please bring certification papers stating such.**

CURRENT 2016 DOG TAGS WILL BE FOR SALE

The Louisa County Treasurer will offer citizens who have their dogs vaccinated on site the opportunity to purchase County dog licenses.

The fee schedule for dog licenses is as follows:

- ❖ \$4.00 per sterilized dog regardless of sex
- ❖ \$10.00 per un-sterilized dog regardless of sex
- ❖ \$45.00 kennel license up to 20 dogs
- ❖ \$50.00 kennel license up to 50 dogs

Citizens are urged to obtain vaccinations and required licenses for their animals if they have not already done so. Enforcement of County ordinances pertaining to such will be exercised.

Citizens are also reminded that Louisa County Animal Control will pick up any stray animal (dogs or cats). Call (540) 967-1234 or (540) 894-4219 during the day. For emergency calls or after hours, call (540) 967-1234.
