

## Agreement for Marina Receiving Clean Vessel Act Funds

This agreement between the Commonwealth of Virginia (Commonwealth) and \_\_\_\_\_  
(Marina Name)

(hereafter known as the marina) is made in order to provide a public facility for the safe removal of sewage from boats and is entered on this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ and provides that:

1. The marina and the Commonwealth will share the cost of installing or maintaining a pump-out station and/or dump station with the State providing 75% of the funds from the Clean Vessel/ (CVA) grant, CFDA# 15.616, and the marina providing the remaining 25%.
2. The design, installation, and operation of the pump-out station and/or dump station must be approved by the Commonwealth, in accordance with State regulations and CVA guidelines.
3. The marina pump-out and/or dump station facility must be accessible to all vessels during normal operating hours, seven days a week from April 15th through November 15th and the pump-out facility is to be used solely for the purpose of removing sewage from boats.
4. The marina may charge a fee of \$5.00 for the use of the pump-out facility for each part of 20 gallons of sewage pumped.
5. The marina will locate and place all appropriate informational signs, as required, at dump stations and pump-out stations indicating location and other information as necessary, including fees, restrictions, hours of operation, operating instructions, and a contact name and telephone number if the facility is inoperable.
6. In the event that the ownership of the marina changes hands, the Marina Program Manager of the Virginia Department of Health shall be promptly notified in writing.
7. If the marina is sold, this agreement shall be incorporated in the sales contract and becomes binding upon the new owner until a new agreement can be executed. The equipment will be returned to the Commonwealth if operation of such is not in compliance with this agreement.
8. Continuation of the program is dependent upon the availability of CVA funding from the United States Fish and Wildlife Service.
9. In order for the marina to utilize funding from this grant, the system must be purchased, installed, and inspected by the Virginia Department of Health, Marina Programs. All bills, invoices, and receipts must be submitted to the Virginia Department of Health, Marina Programs prior to reimbursement.
