


## Prostate Cancer, Percent Stage at Diagnosis by Race, Age, and Stage, Virginia, 2003 - 2012

Diagnosis at an early stage results in better patient outcomes. In Virginia, the percentage of men aged 40 - 79 with an early stage diagnosis of prostate differs by no more than 1%. Diagnosis at later stages results in poorer patient outcomes. In Virginia, the percentage of black men with distant stage diagnoses is higher in all age groups.
