

Covered Insect Repellants for Zika Virus Prevention

August 2016

Selected insect repellants are now fully covered and available through a pharmacy for Optima Family Care members *effective August 10, 2016*. Coverage is available to currently pregnant women, and men and women between the ages of 14-44. A single prescription is limited to one package per individual, including one refill only, per month. A prescription is required from a physician. It is important to discuss this prescription with your doctor if you have any questions. **Covered insect repellants are below:**

What is Zika virus? Zika is a mosquito-borne virus that spreads mostly through mosquito bites. Almost 1 in 5 infected people infected with Zika get sick. Those who do get sick may experience a fever, rash, joint pain and/ or red eyes. Pregnant women can be infected with Zika virus at any time in their pregnancy, and can pass the infection to their baby. Zika infections have been seen in infants with microcephaly.
