Why do these tests provide peace of mind?

Out of every 1,000 mammograms, only one or two lead to a cancer diagnosis. In the case of Pap tests, only about six percent show abnormalities. The screening tests are quick, simple, and provide minimal discomfort. Your appointment also will include a free clinical breast and pelvic exam.

More important, if these tests lead to a cancer diagnosis, successful treatment can increase dramatically with early detection. Also, Medicaid may provide treatment free of charge.

Who qualifies for free screening?

Screening is free if ALL of the following applies:

- Age 40-64*
- A resident of Virginia
- No insurance
- Yearly income falls within federal poverty guidelines

*Every Woman's Life can enroll women between the ages of 18-39 with abnormal Pap tests or if you have a lump in your breast.
