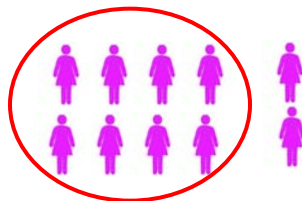
## HIV & AIDS IMPACTS BLACK WOMEN IN VIRGINIA

♀ Black women represent approximately **10%** of the total population in Virginia and account for **20%** of all Virginians living with HIV disease.

♀ **1** out of every **5** Virginians living with HIV disease is a Black woman.



♀ In Virginia, **8** out of every **10** women living with HIV disease are Black.



♀ Black women are **15** times more likely to be living with HIV disease than White women.

♀ Black women are **4** times more likely to be living with HIV disease than Hispanic women

♀ In Virginia **1** in every:

♀ **178** Black women is living with HIV disease.

♀ **740** Hispanic women is living with HIV disease.

♀ **2,703** White women is living with HIV disease.
