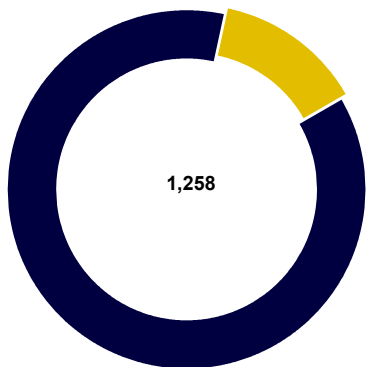

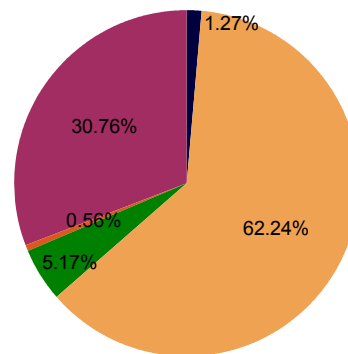
Gender Proportions

Reported Cases of TES by Region, Year to Date

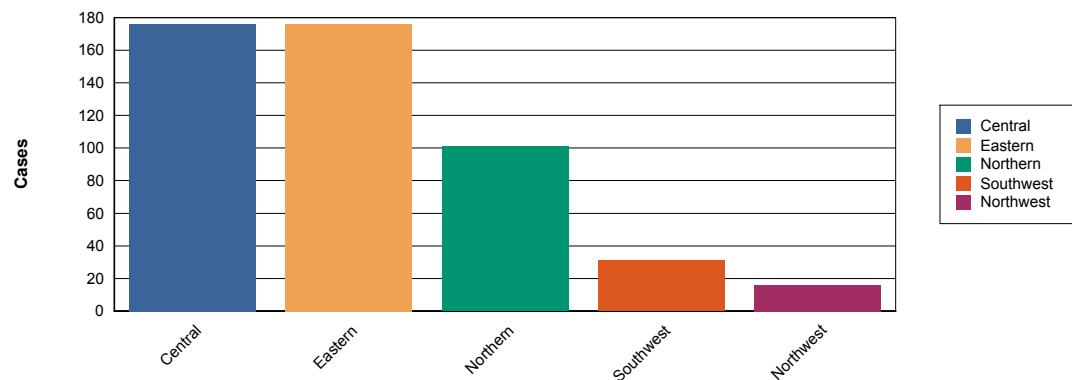

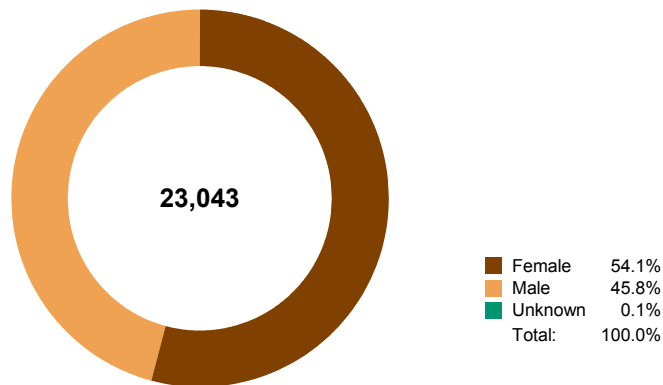

Cumulative for Qtrs in Table

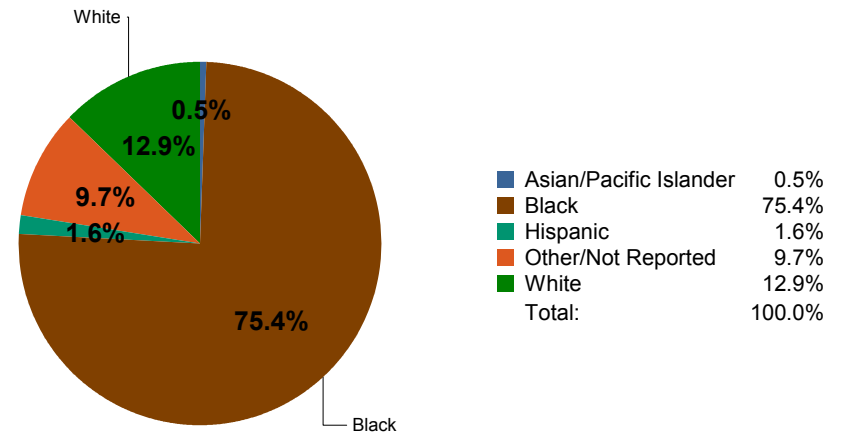

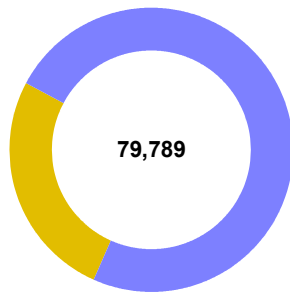

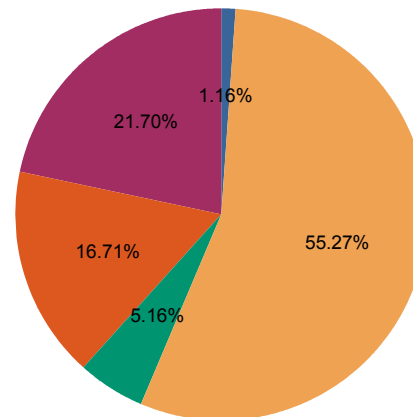
