- ✓ **Get current prescriptions with at least 3 refills for all of your ADAP medications**
- ✓ **Choose a new medical provider**
- ✓ **Sign a medical records release so your new provider can get your information**

You may be able to receive your medical care from the sites listed below. As you review this list, please contact the agency prior to visiting, so that you will be sure you are eligible to receive medical care at that site. (This is especially important if you are currently Ryan White eligible and do not have private insurance, Medicaid or Medicare.)
