

# VVFC ELIGIBILITY & HEALTH PLANS

## Eligible for VVFC Vaccines

A VVFC Provider can provide VVFC vaccine to children under 19 years of age who meet one of the following criteria:

- Under-insured at a FQHC/RHC facility (*private insurance doesn't cover immunizations or children whose insurance covers only select vaccines or caps the vaccine cost at a certain limit*)
- Un-insured (*no health insurance*)
- American Indian/ Alaskan Native (*must be a member of a tribe*)
- Medicaid enrolled (FAMIS Plus)
- Medallion II – Medicaid HMO *administered through the following contracted MCO's:*
  - Virginia Premier Health Plan (1-800-828-7989)
  - Optima Health (1-800-881-2166)
  - CareNet (1-800-279-1878)
  - UNICARE Health Plan of Virginia (1-888-229-3872)
  - AMERIGROUP, Inc. (1-888-454-3730)
  - Anthem (1-800-901-0020)*(administered by Health Keepers Plus, Inc. Priority Health Care and Peninsula Health Care, Inc.)*

Vaccines are free through VVFC. Use CPT codes to bill for the administration fee. Optional administration fee for uninsured can be charged directly to the patient/parent.

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## Not Eligible for VVFC Vaccines

*Patients do not qualify for VFC vaccine if they are:*

- 19 years of age or older
- Privately Insured (*includes patients who have not met their deductibles*)
- Under-insured at a PRIVATE facility/PUBLIC HOSPITAL/Health Department (*private insurance not covering immunizations*)
- FAMIS administered by:
  - Optima Health FAMIS
  - UNICARE FAMIS
  - Anthem Health Keepers Plus FAMIS
  - VA Premier FAMIS
  - AMERIGROUP FAMIS

**NOTE: A non-VFC eligible patient may qualify for free vaccines under certain circumstances at Local Health Departments, Federally Qualified Health Centers, and Regional Health Centers.**
