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SERVICES TO ORGANIZATIONS

Our Preventive Vision Care Program provides high - quality, affordable and even free preventive and primary vision care for members and families through the following services:

1. Vision Screening Programs:

Screening for possible eye problems among the U.S. populations of all ages, develops a solid beginning to healthy eye care. Although a screening does not replace a professional eye examination it can help to identify individuals at risk for eye disease or in need of exam by an eye care professional, where a diagnosis and treatment can be provided.

Our screenings emphasize the importance of regular professional eye examination, subject evaluation and effective follow-up. This service is provided on- site for free or at a low cost.

2. Eye clinic services :

The professional members of the Eye Care Network provide specialized services for free or at reduced fees to those patients referred to the Institute. This may be also provided on – site previous review and coordination trough our mobile clinic.

3. Patient referral and case management :

This service provides information and referrals to external programs and community resources available based on specific needs of individuals creating more options for low income families and individuals.

4. Optical services at nominal prices :

Fees for eyeglasses vary. Usually there is a co-payment depending on materials, frames, type of lenses required or specialties.

5. Educative and informative services.

This service is provided through conferences, workshops, distribution of printed materials as well on an individual basis during the vision screening programs.
