I have reviewed your request to grant a continuation of the waiver of experimental status for the Infiltrator chamber system.

Based on the previous information submitted with your 1991 application for the same waiver and lacking any knowledge of adverse public health affects based on the 15 installations we are aware have been made in Virginia, I am granting an extension of the previously issued waiver. The following conditions apply to this waiver:

1. This waiver is granted without an expiration date. This waiver may be rescinded at any time provided written notice is issued giving at least 30 days notice of my intention to rescind the waiver and granting Infiltrator the option of a hearing in accordance with the Virginia Administrative Process Act.
2. All systems shall be sized on actual bottom area and shall be equal to a conventional drainfield in square footage of bottom area.
3. Infiltrator Systems, Inc., shall notify the Division of Onsite Sewage and Water Services of each installation made within the Commonwealth of Virginia. Such notification shall include the VDH permit number and shall be made not later than the 15th of the month following installation.

I have reviewed your request to grant a waiver of experimental status for the Hancor EnviroChamber™ set system.

Based on the information submitted with your November 4, 1994 letter and previous waivers issued to other chamber systems in Virginia, I am granting Hancor, Inc. a waiver to § 2.25 A and § 2.25 B of the Sewage Handling and Disposal Regulations for the EnviroChamber™ System. The following conditions apply to this waiver:

1. This waiver is granted without an expiration date. This waiver may be rescinded at any time provided written notice is issued giving at least 30 days notice of my intention to rescind the waiver and granting Hancor, Inc. the option of a hearing in accordance with the Virginia Administrative Process Act.
