SUBJECT: Use of Primer on PVC-DWV Foam Core Pipe

The Charlotte Pipe and Foundry Company of Charlotte, NC has provided Technical Services with a copy of a memorandum it wrote on July 22, 1992. The memorandum states that the use of primer/cleaner on PVC-DWV core pipe, when used in accordance with ASTM D-2855, and in accordance with the primer/cleaner manufacture's recommendations, will not have an adverse effect on PVC-DWV foam core pipe. This memorandum was developed in response to its previous memorandum, dated July 7, 1992, which said that Charlotte Pipe and Foundry Company, Plastics Division does not recommend the use of primer on DWV systems, including foam core pipe. According to Alan Biggers, Senior Vice President for Charlotte Pipe and Foundry Company, the July 22, 1992 memorandum supersedes the July 7, 1992 memorandum. For the sake of simplicity, I have attached a copy of only the July 22, 1992 memorandum.
