Greetings Partners:

Please accept this correspondence as the Virginia Department of Health's (VDH) Notification of Required Annual Training for all Program operators participating in the CACFP. The State Agency is responsible for providing annual training specific to Program duties and responsibilities for key staff from all independent centers and sponsoring organizations.

Per Federal regulations Section 7, Part CFR 226, attendance by key staff, as defined by the State agency, is required prior to administration of CACFP operations. Key staff includes the following:

- **Executive Director**
- **Business Owner (for –profit)**
- **Center Director**
- **Authorized Representative**
- **Program Coordinator/ Contact**
- **Financial staff involved with budget and claim preparation**
- **Staff involved in free and reduced priced determinations**
- **Teachers**
- **Monitors**
- **Direct Care Staff**
- **Cooks**
- **Staff involved in Meal Services**

Annual State agency CACFP training for Federal fiscal Year (FFY) 2026-2027 is now available online. Details regarding online training are below:

Additional required training modules continue to be revised and updated based on revised United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) policies. Please look for these additional training modules to go live by August 10, 2026.

Completion of annual CACFP training is required for key staff of independent centers and sponsoring organizations, appropriate to the level of staff duties. As part of the Annual CACFP Certification requirements, organizations must upload their training Certificates of Completion into the Child and Adult Application and Meal Payment System (CHAAMPS) Attachment List section of the Application Packet. Noncompliance with this training requirement will result in delay and/or denial of the organization's application/annual certification for FY27.
