

# INTEGRATED HIV PREVENTION AND CARE PLAN

2022-2026

## PURPOSE

Virginia's Integrated HIV Prevention and Care Plan is a roadmap for HIV services over a five-year period, allowing us to **prevent** HIV transmission, **improve** health for people living with HIV, and ultimately **end** Virginia's HIV epidemic. The plan serves as the joint jurisdictional plan for Virginia, which is a Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program (RWHAP) Part B recipient, and for the Norfolk, Virginia RWHAP Part A Transitional Grant Area (TGA).

**GOAL 1:** Prevent New HIV Infections

**GOAL 2:** Increasing Access To Care & Improving Health Outcomes For People With HIV

**GOAL 3:** Reduce HIV-Related Disparities & Health Inequities

**GOAL 4:** Achieve Integrated, Coordinated Efforts That Address the HIV Epidemic among All Partners and Interested Parties

## PRIORITY POPULATIONS

Young Persons, Latino/Latinx, Black Heterosexual Men and Women, Trans Women, People who Use/Inject Drugs, Elderly, Rural Residents, Men who Have Sex with Men (MSM)

Based on the four EHE (Ending the HIV Epidemic in the U.S.) Pillars, many themes emerged during Virginia's community engagement and planning process, Epidemiological snapshot, resource inventory, and needs assessment. **Below are some examples.**



### DIAGNOSE

#### Strengths

Availability of testing, Training quality

#### Challenges

Stigma, Routine testing

#### Needs

More training, Provider de-stigmatization



### TREAT

#### Strengths

Expand Comprehensive Harm Reduction, Condom distribution, Create status neutral service navigation program

#### Challenges

PrEP funding, Stigma, Support services

#### Needs

Funding support, Stigma education



### PREVENT

#### Strengths

Links to care, Medicaid expansion

#### Challenges

Housing, Case management staff transportation

#### Needs

Services for aging, Mental health and substance use providers



### RESPOND

#### Strengths

Outbreak rapid response plan

#### Challenges

Local healthcare staff availability, Funding for surveillance

#### Needs

Community education, Local HIV surveillance
