



#### Prevalence-based HIV Care Continuum, U.S. and 6 Dependent Areas, 2019




- diagnosis of HIV infection

#### National HIV/AIDS Strategy Goals for the HIV Continuum of Care


HIV Continuum of Care Measure	2025 Goal
Linkage to HIV care within 30 days	95% (from 77.8% in 2017)
Retention in care	Objective: Increase retention in care and adherence to HIV treatment to achieve and maintain long-term viral suppression and provide integrative HIV services for HIV-associated comorbidities, coinfections, and complications, including STIs.
Viral suppression	95% (from 63.1% in 2017)

#### HIV Care Continuum, People Living with HIV (PLWH) in Virginia, 2021









#### HIV Care Continuum, All CHARLII Clients (n=194), 2021




#### CHARLII Client Age Distribution (as of 12/2022)




# HIV Care Continuum, CHARLII Clients ages 13-35 (n=43), 2021






#### CHARLII Clients by Risk Factor (n=194), 2021
