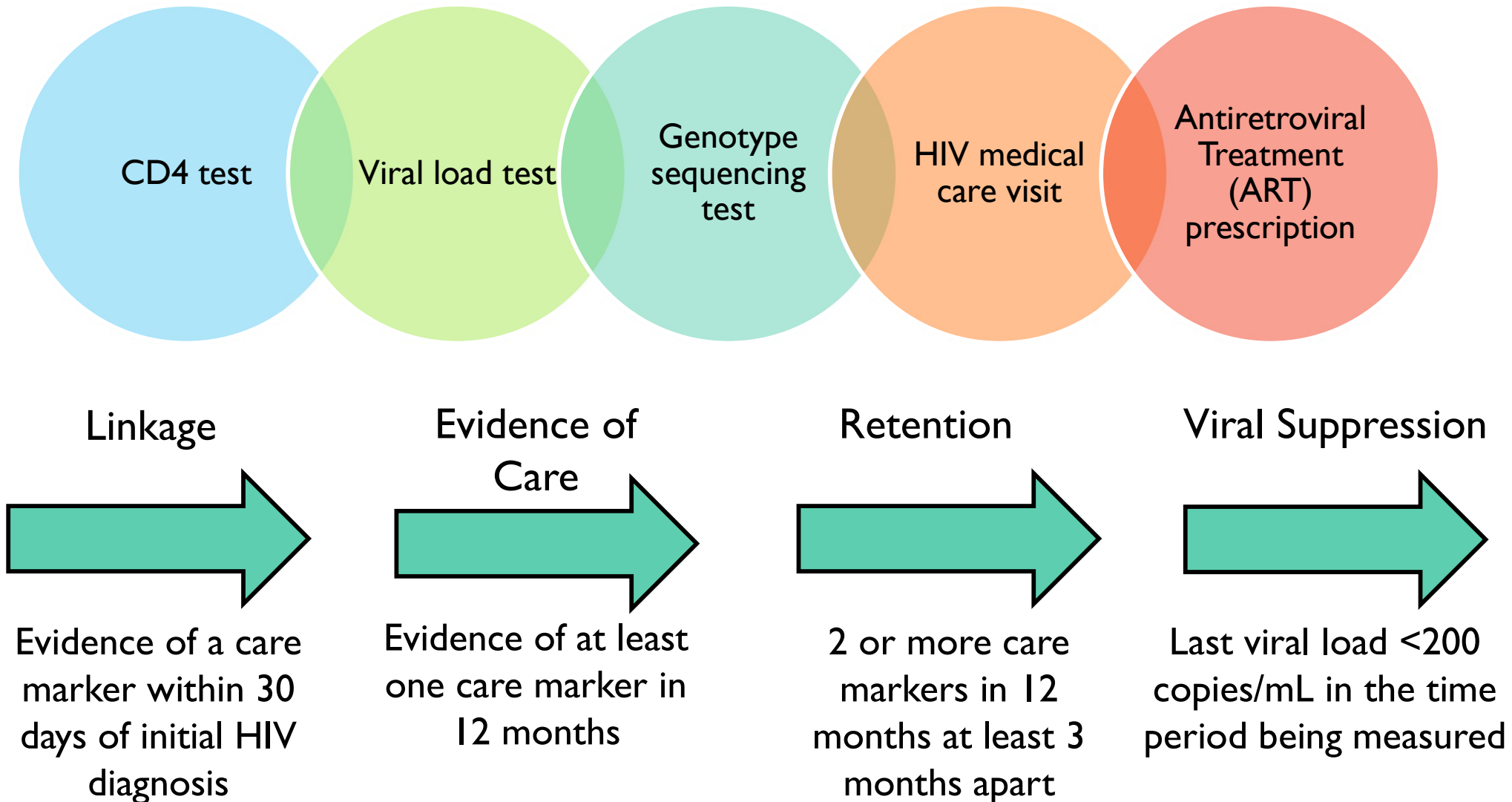

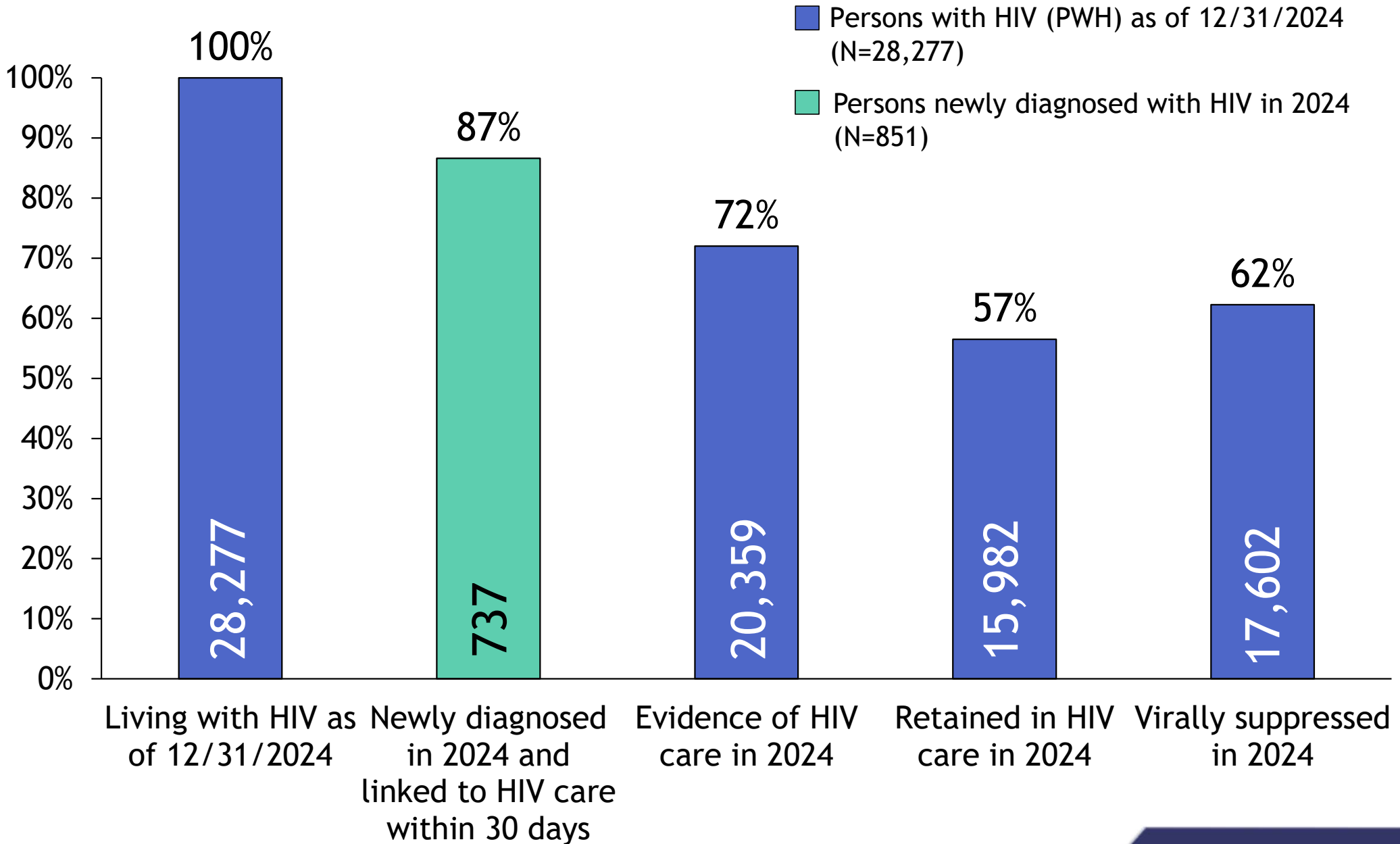

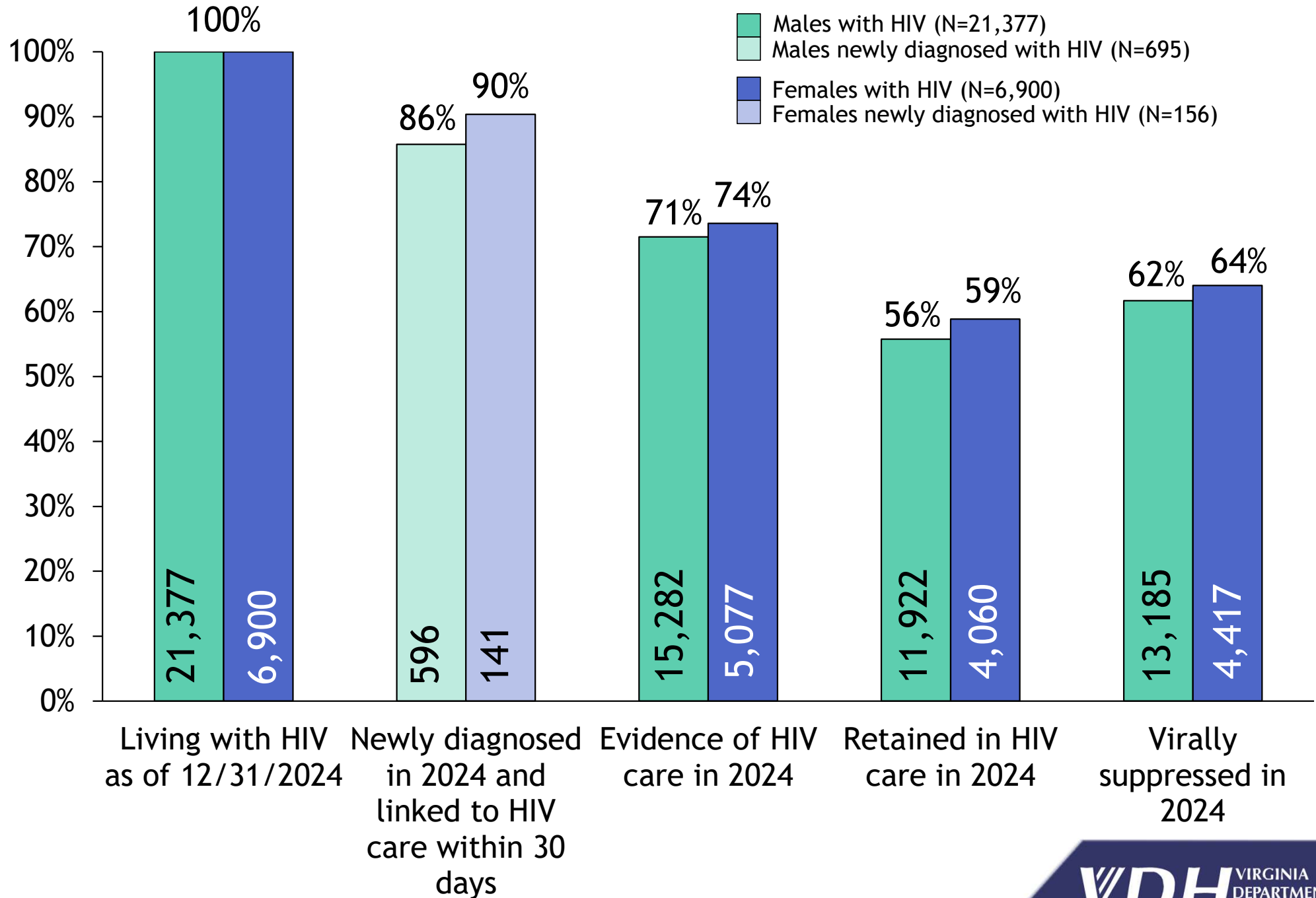

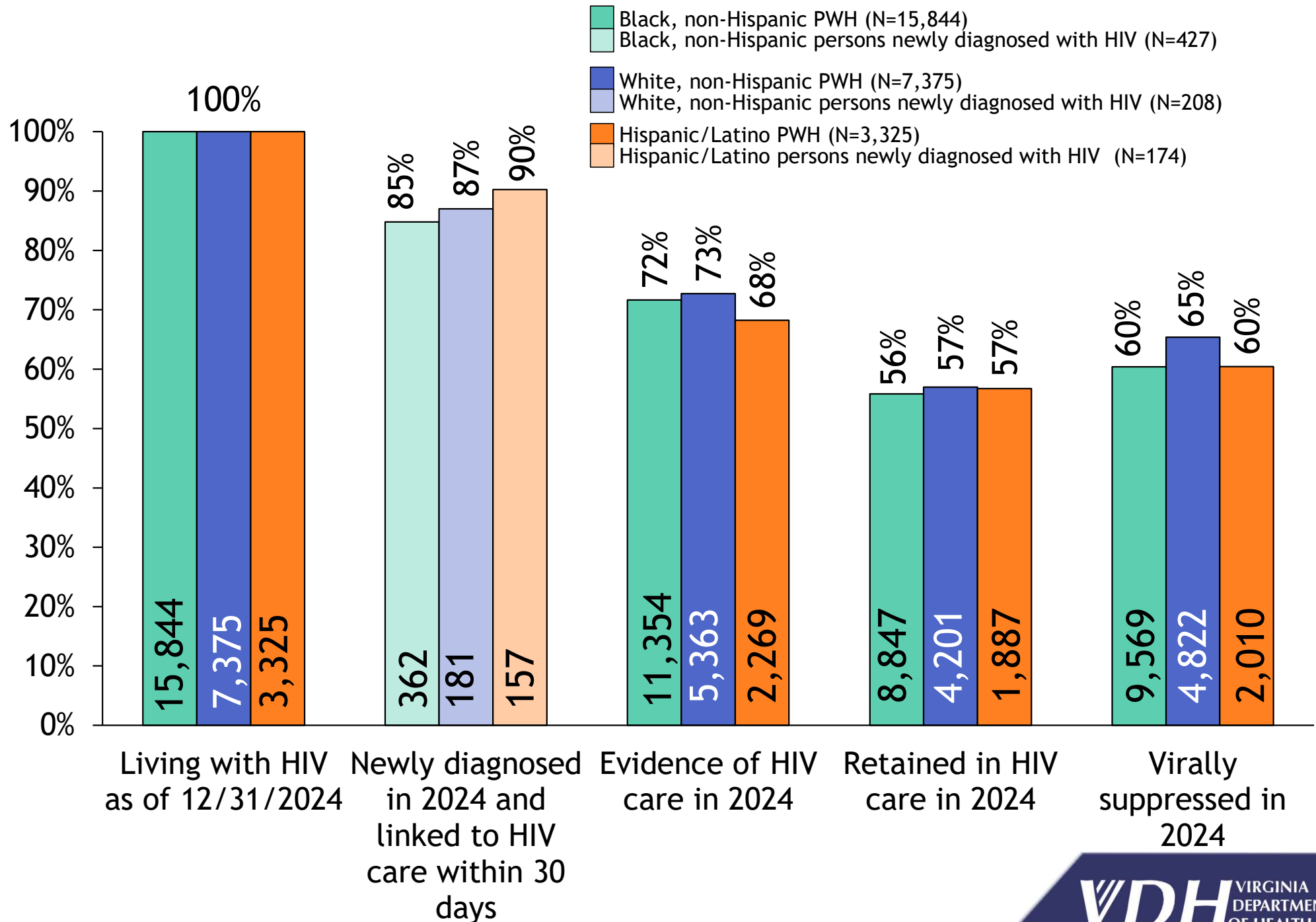

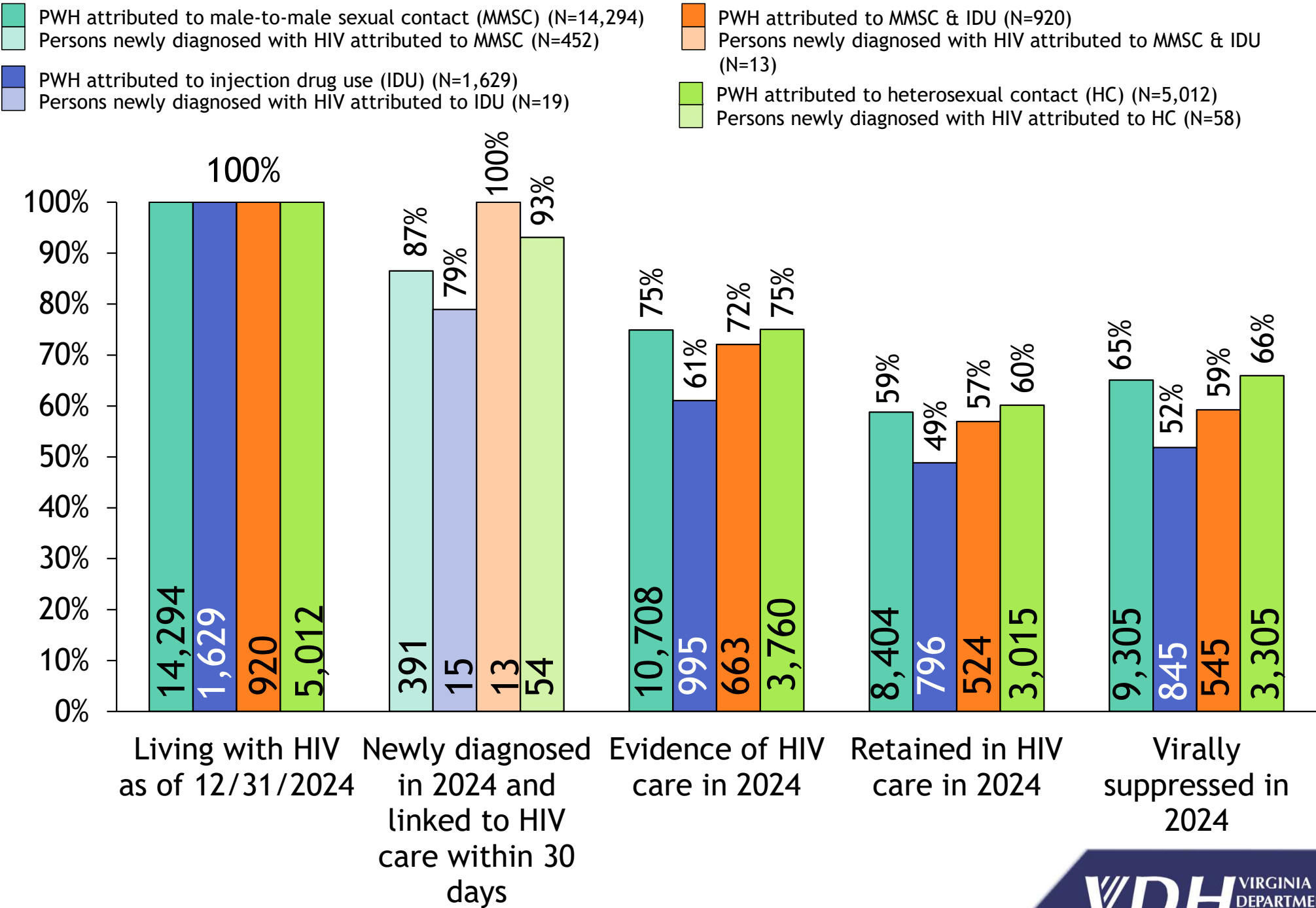
# HIV Continuum of Care by Sex at Birth in Virginia, 2024



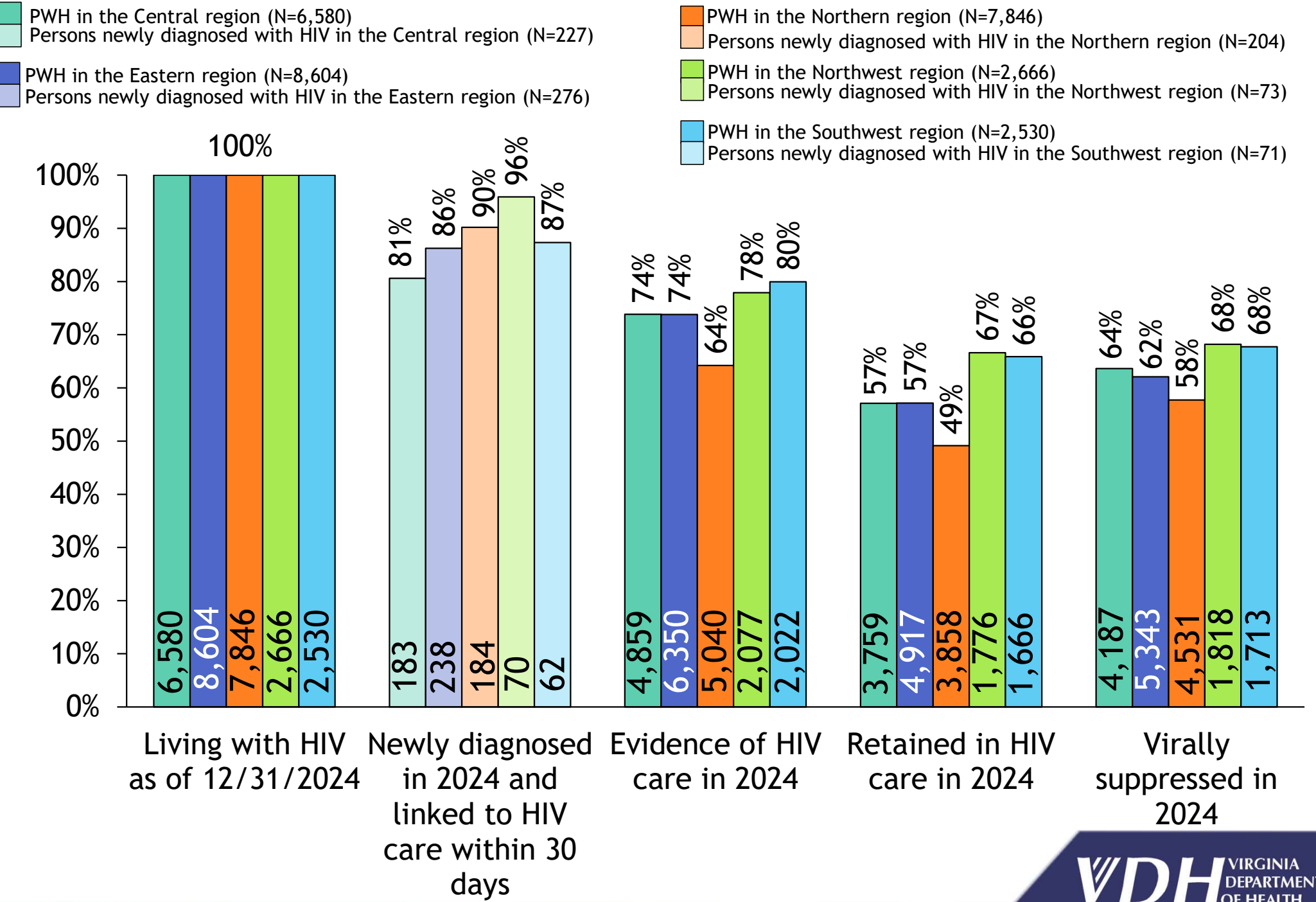
# HIV Continuum of Care by Race/Ethnicity in Virginia, 2024

# HIV Continuum of Care by Age in Virginia, 2024

- Persons ages 15-24 with HIV (N=646)
- Persons newly diagnosed with HIV at 15-24 years (N=182)
- Persons ages 25-34 with HIV (N=4,256)
- Persons newly diagnosed with HIV at 25-34 years (N=307)

- Persons ages 35-44 with HIV (N=5,633)
- Persons newly diagnosed with HIV at 35-44 years (N=200)
- Persons ages 45-54 with HIV (N=5,575)
- Persons newly diagnosed with HIV at 45-54 years (N=98)
- Persons ages 55+ with HIV (N=12,130)
- Persons newly diagnosed with HIV at 55+ years (N=64)
