## Who Qualifies for an iPad?

- A child with a diagnosis of hearing loss and verified in VISITS
- A child under 5 years of age
- Reside in Virginia
- Does not have an iPad in the home
- Plans to use the iPad for one or more of the project guidelines below:
  - Virtual Early Intervention,
  - Learn American Sign Language (ASL),
  - Participate in telehealth with their child's providers,
  - Connect with family-to-family support services, and other communication options
