Next Steps

- Enter hearing loss test results into Virginia Infant Screening Tracking System(VISITS) as soon as possible. This is essential for automated referral to early intervention.
- Repeat ABR or hearing exam if needed.
- Send a copy of the child's audiology report to their PCP.
- Consider the following (optional based on parent choice):
 - amplification
 - assistive listening devices
 - cochlear implant evaluation
 - manual modes of communication (ASL, cued speech, etc.)

Explain to the Family

- Hearing loss in terms they understand
- Possible communication options
- The treatment plan for the child's type and degree of hearing loss
- The benefits of early intervention for children with hearing loss: Have the family call 800-234-1448 or go to www.infantva.org to enroll

Refer

- To otolaryngology (ENT)–for hearing aid clearance; may refer for imaging.
- Other specialists as needed:
 - Ophthalmologist
 - Genetics
 - Developmental pediatrician
 - Neurologist
 - Cardiologist
 - Nephrologist
 - Infectious Disease specialist
