

Eligible for VFC Vaccine

18 years of age or younger and meet one of the following criteria:

- 1. **Medicaid MCO** administered through the following contracted MCO's:
 - Aetna Better Health 1-800-279-1878 or TTY: 711
 - Anthem HealthKeepers Plus 1-800-901-0020 or TTY: 711
 - Humana Healthly Horizons 1-800-457-4708 or TTY: 711
 - Sentara Community Plan: 1-800-881-2166 or TTY: 711 (Northern VA Kaiser Permanente members: 1-855-249-5025)
 - UnitedHealthCare Community Plan 1-844-752-9434 or TTY: 711
- 2. **Medicaid Enrolled** (FAMIS Plus)
- 3. **Uninsured** (no health insurance)
- 4. American Indian/ Alaskan Native
 - As defined by the Indian Health Care Improvement Act (25 U.S.C. 1603)
- 5. Under-insured at a FQHC/RHC facility
 - Underinsured is defined as a child who has health insurance, but the
 coverage does not include vaccines; a child whose insurance covers only
 selected vaccines (VFC-eligible for non-covered vaccines only); a child whose
 insurance does not include first-dollar coverage for a vaccine. Underinsured
 children are eligible to receive VFC vaccine only through a Federally Qualified
 Health Center (FQHC), or Rural Health Clinic (RHC) or under an approved
 deputization agreement.

Use CPT codes to bill for the administration fee. An optional administration fee for **uninsured** may be charged directly to the client. This fee may not exceed \$21.24 per injection.

Not Eligible for VFC Vaccine

Non-VFC eligible clients may qualify for DOI-supplied vaccines at Local Health Departments, Federally Qualified Health Centers, and Rural Health Clinics. An administration fee may apply. FAMIS Insurance administered by the managed care plans above are NOT VFC eligible. FAMIS is insurance. Insured clients are not eligible for federally purchased vaccine.
