# Quantitative Data, Strengths


- Ranked among healthiest counties in VA (highest 25%)

|                         | Stafford County | Virginia   |
|-------------------------|-----------------|------------|
| Life expectancy         | 80.1 years      | 79.5 years |
| Poor or fair health     | 14%             | 17%        |
| Food insecurity         | 6%              | 10%        |
| Severe housing problems | 10%             | 15%        |
| High school graduation  | 93%             | 90%        |
| Physical inactivity     | 16%             | 22%        |


# Quantitative Data, Weaknesses

|                             | Stafford County | Virginia |
|-----------------------------|-----------------|----------|
| Primary care physicians     | 3,260: 1        | 1,330: 1 |
| Dentists                    | 2,940: 1        | 1,410: 1 |
| Mental health providers     | 1,220: 1        | 530: 1   |
| Income inequality           | 3.5             | 4.8      |
| Long commute, driving alone | 55%             | 41%      |

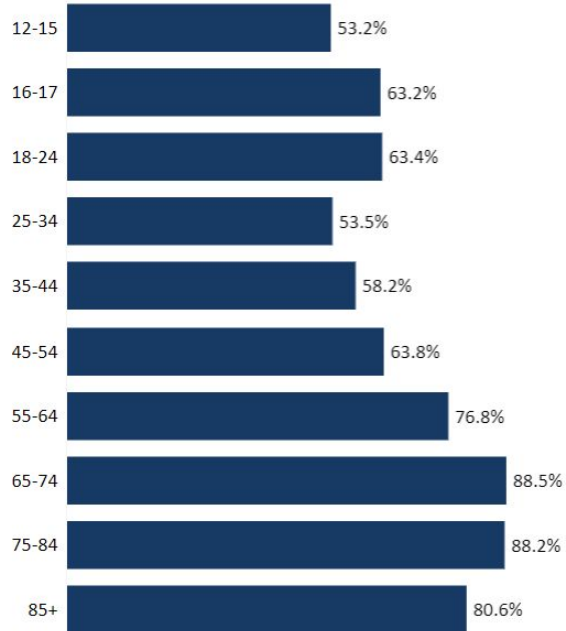

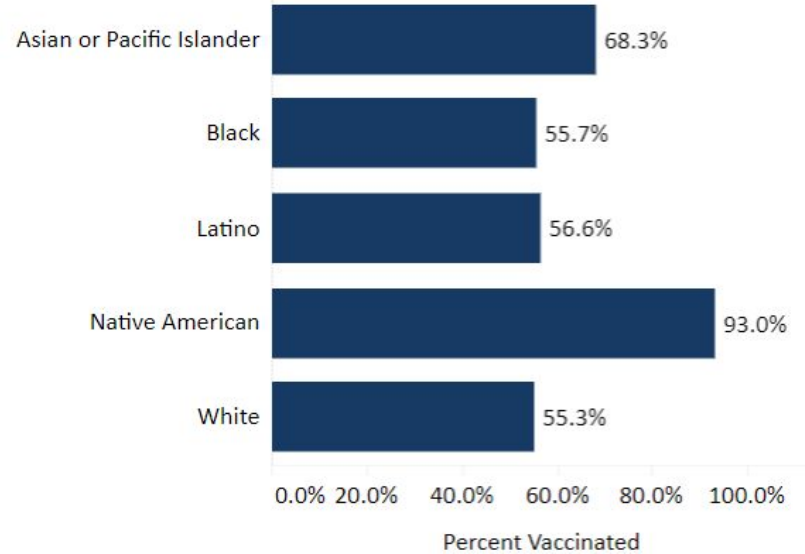

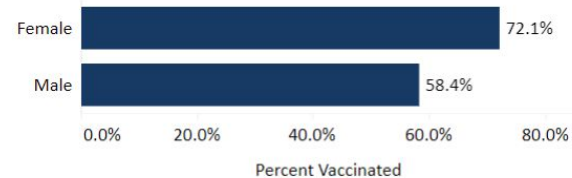
Percent of the Population Vaccinated with At Least One Dose - By Age Group

Percent of the Eligible Population Vaccinated with At Least One Dose - By Sex

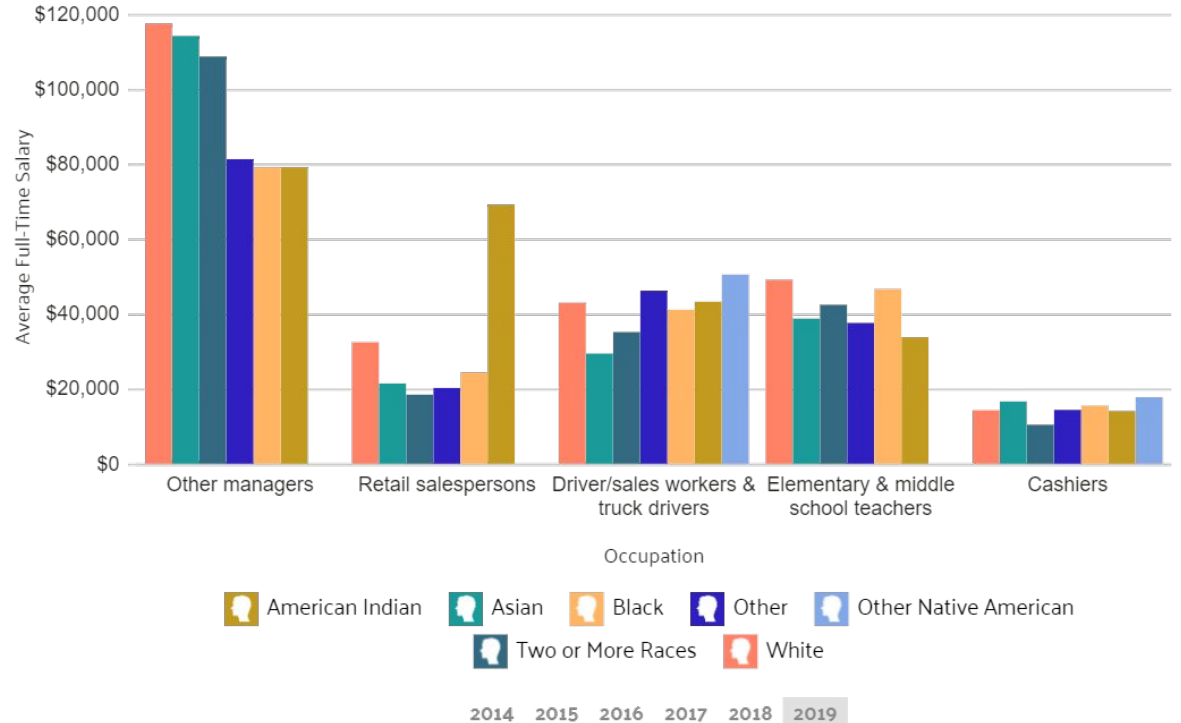

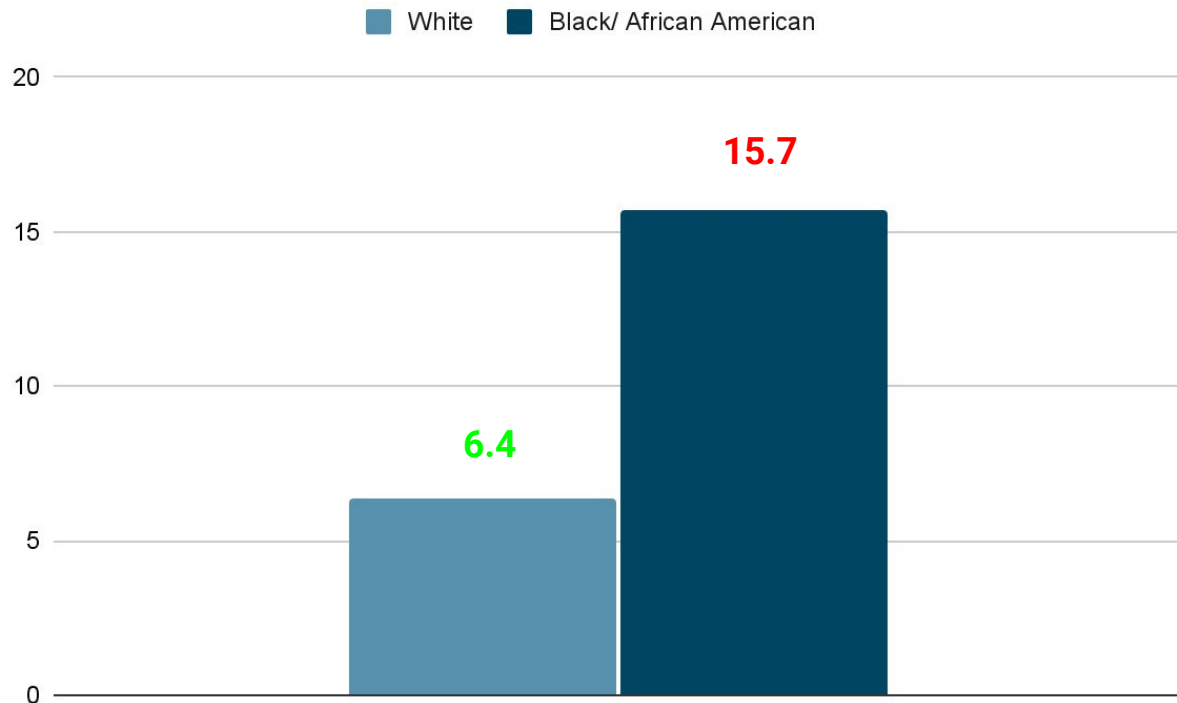
## Wage by Race and Ethnicity in Common Jobs, 2019

# Survey Questions– Demographics


- Zip code\*
- Age (given in ranges)\*
- Race/ethnicity\*
- Gender\*
- Highest level of education
- Annual household income

\*indicates required question

# Data Collection Methods

- Convenience sample (non-representative)
- Data collection to take place in November
- Requesting community partners help in distribution
- Utilize CHWs and MRC volunteers for hard-to-reach areas
- Stratify data based on demographic factors
- Goals:
  - 2000 survey responses
  - Try to align with population trends for race and zip code
