## Infection Prevention Ambassadors

Henrico/Chickahominy and Richmond City MRC volunteers were actively involved the June and November 2020 elections. Volunteer served as Infection Prevention Ambassadors at polling locations, making sure voters practiced social distancing and infection prevention methods!



## Vaccination Clinics — Big and Small!



Our first vaccination clinic was December 28, 2020. Since then, volunteers have dedicated over **54,000 hours** just to vaccination clinics alone! MRC supported mass vaccination sites like Arthur Ashe, Ashland Food Lion, George Wythe, Randolph Macon College, and Virginia Union University. They also supported mobile clinics!

## COVID Screenings

Starting in May of 2020, MRC volunteers helped the local health departments and government buildings with screening staff, community members, and other volunteers for COVID-19. We dedicated almost **6,000 hours** just to screening individuals!



## Community Partnerships



During COVID, our MRC units had the opportunity to partner with a wide variety of organizations, whether for testing or vaccination sites! We proudly supported our partners at Capiatal Area Health Network (CAHN), Hanover Fire, all of the local area governments, Richmond Raceway, Hope Pharmacy, Health Brigade, and more!

**JUN 23/20** 98 Henrico/Chickahominy and Richmond volunteers supported the primary elections as Infection Prevention Ambassadors

**NOV 3/20** 58 Henrico/Chickahominy and Richmond volunteers supported the Presidential elections as Infection Prevention Ambassadors

**DEC 28/20** Henrico/Chickahominy and Richmond volunteers support the first mass vaccination event in the area and vaccinate 240 individuals
