**Confinement information**

3. THE ANIMAL MUST REMAIN SECURELY CONFINED UNTIL RELEASED BY THE HEALTH DEPT. AND CANNOT BE REMOVED FROM THE PREMISES WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT.

In accordance with the Health Laws of Virginia, Sec. 3.1-796.98, by signing this notice the owner agrees to confine his/her animal for the specified period of time and further agrees to notify the Health Department if the animal becomes sick, dies, or escapes during the confinement period.

You are reminded that state law requires all cats and dogs, 4 months of age and older to be vaccinated against rabies and that all dogs within the locality must have an annual dog license which can be purchased from the localities Treasurer's office with proof of vaccination.
