

LEAD-SAFE CLEANING

Always wear gloves when cleaning lead dust

How to safely clean lead dust inside your home

Cleaning Windowsills & Tables

- 1 Fill the spray bottle with soap and water. Spray the surface with the spray bottle.**
This keeps any lead dust from flying up into the air when you wipe the surface



- 2 Wipe the surface with a disposable towel.**
Throw away the towel in the trash bag after cleaning the area. Wipe away any soap suds with a new towel dipped in clean water. Re-using towels can contaminate the area you just cleaned.

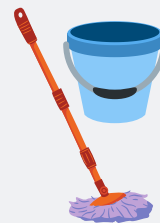


Cleaning Floors & Entryways

- 1 Fill one bucket with soapy water, one with plain water, and leave one bucket empty.**



- 2 Dip the mop in the soapy water and clean a small section of the floor. After, rinse the mop in the bucket with the plain water. Then, wring out the mop in the empty bucket.** Never dip the dirty mop back into the soapy water before rinsing it in the plain water. This keeps the lead dust from spreading while cleaning.



- 3 Flush the water from all three buckets down the toilet after you are done cleaning.**
This is the safest way to get rid of dirty water that may contain lead.

Gloves



Disposable towels



Spray bottle with soap & water



Trash bag



3 buckets



Mop
