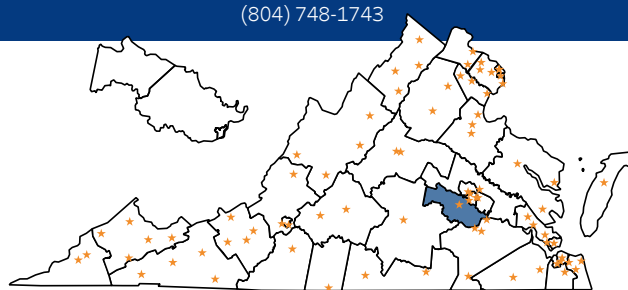

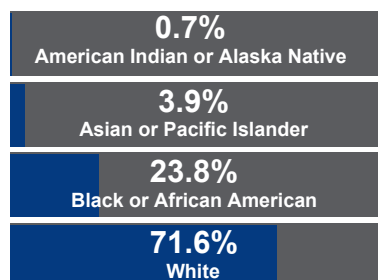

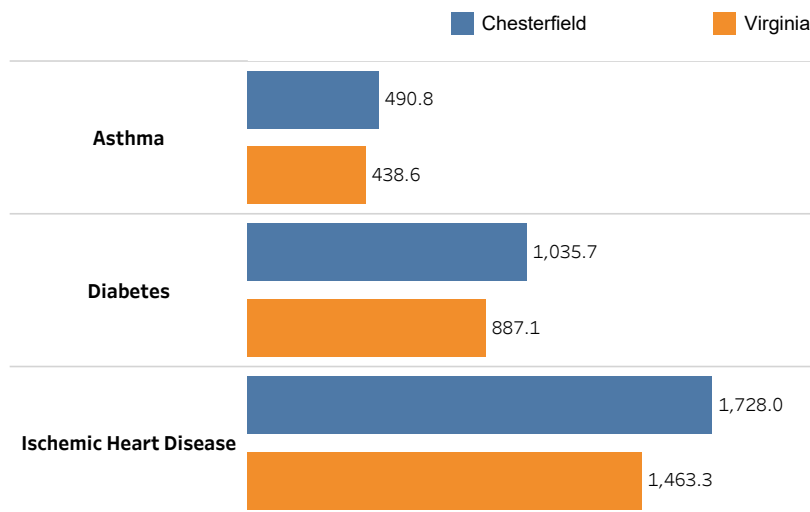

Chronic Disease Hospitalization Rates (2017)

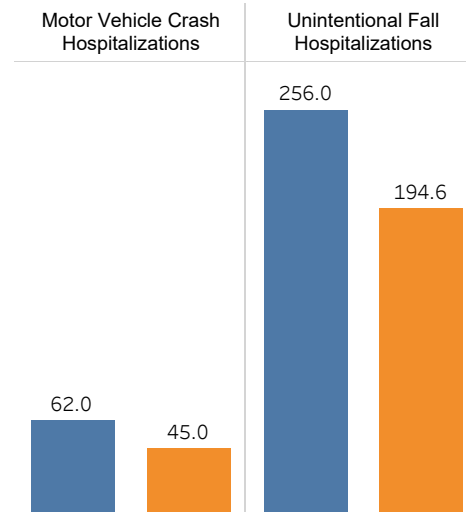

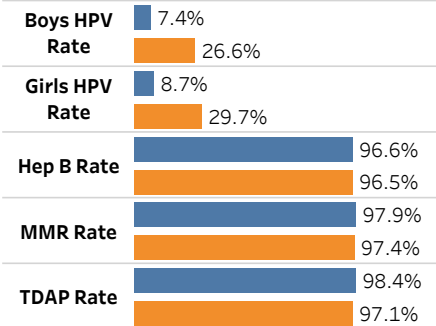

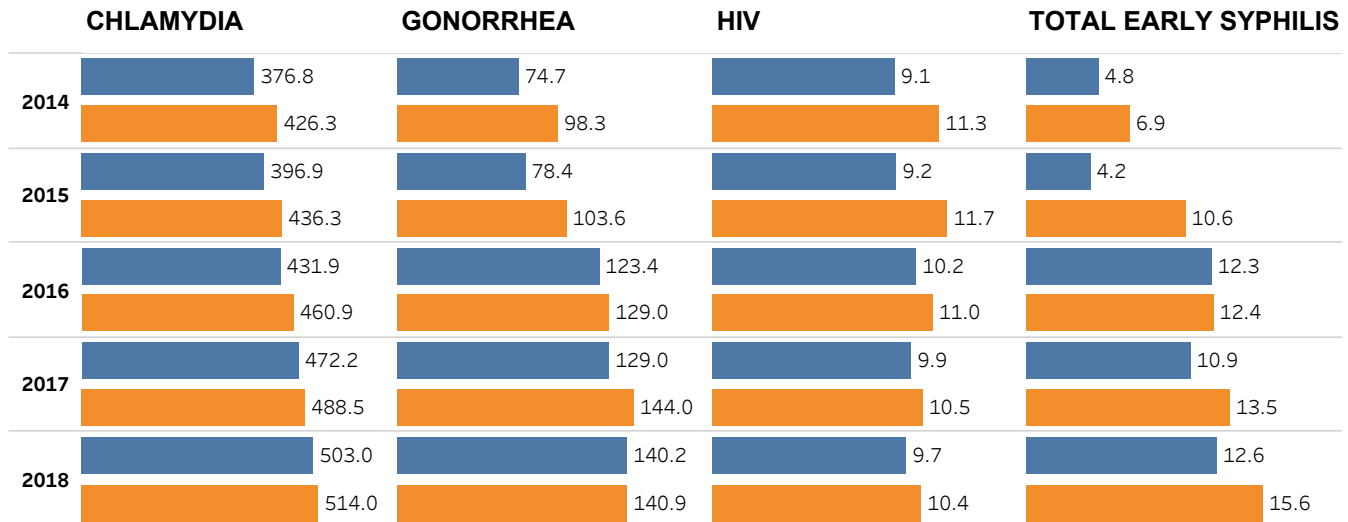
7th Grade Vaccination Rates (Fall 2019)

STI Rates (2018)

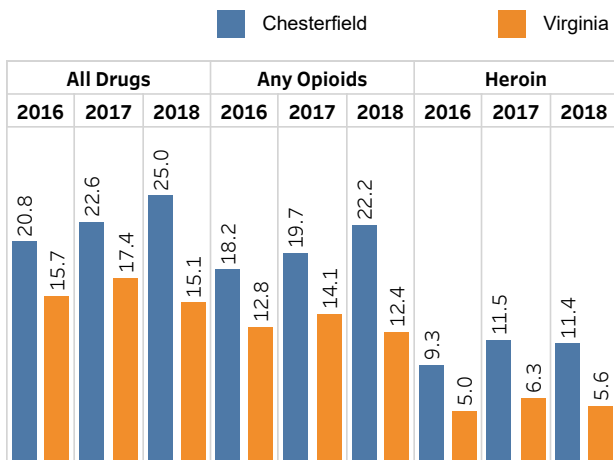

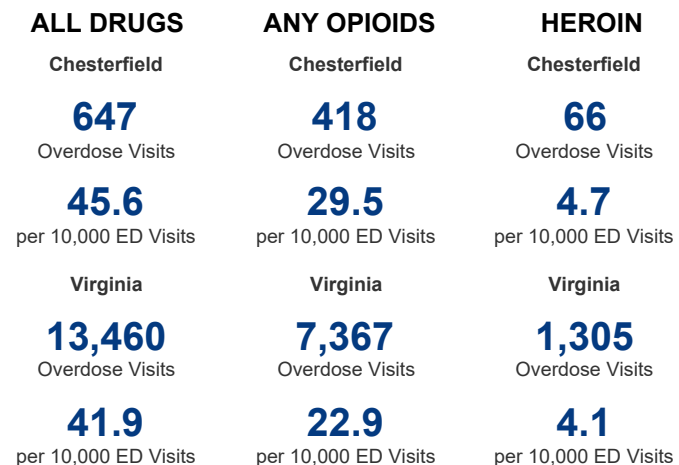
Overdose Death Rates (2018)
