

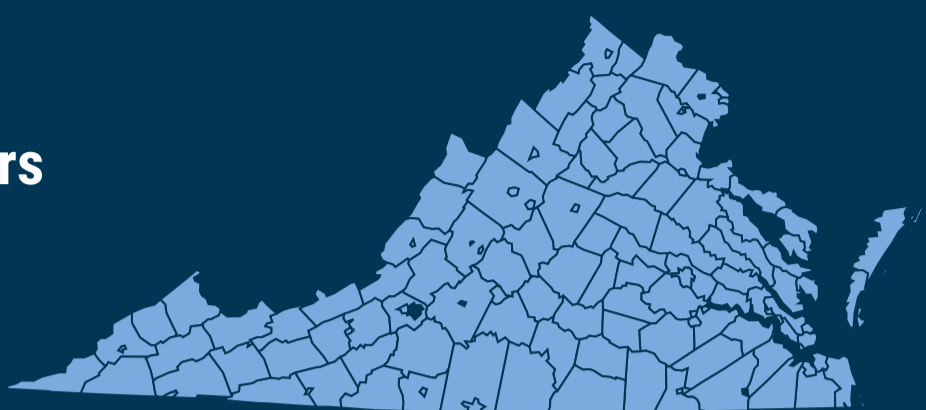

VIRGINIA MRC COVID TIMELINE HIGHLIGHTS

FROM FEBRUARY 8TH - JUNE 30TH, 2020

CONTACT TRACING & EPI SUPPORT

VA MRC Volunteers performed **22,408 hours** of contact tracing and assistance to local health district's epidemiology and outbreak investigation teams equating a monetary value of over **\$637,717**. In preparation, volunteers completed **1,156 epidemiology courses**.

PUBLIC INFORMATION

VA MRC volunteers began call center operations support March 10th to answer COVID-19 questions. As the longest and largest VA MRC COVID-19 deployment still underway, call center and outreach volunteers provided nearly **21,000 hours** of COVID-19 education for a value of **\$594,928**.

TESTING OPERATIONS

VA MRC volunteers supported **170** COVID-19 community and long-term care facility testing missions resulting in a monetary value of **\$266,977** in workforce savings. VA MRC units mobilized COVID-19 testing teams staffed 100% by volunteers.

LONG-TERM CARE FACILITY SUPPORT

VA MRC volunteers deployed to address workforce challenges in long-term care facilities due to COVID-19, by providing time sensitive critical care for at-risk residents. **106 volunteers** contributed **2,103 hours** for a personnel value of \$63,708. This included an extensive regional deployment of 39 medical and support volunteers from 4 VA MRC units.

INFECTION PREVENTION

662 Infection Prevention Ambassadors deployed to support June primary election operations for VA MRC's largest single day mission. VA MRC units also provided N95 Fit-testing, at 128 events, for healthcare providers, public health staff and first responders. VA MRC volunteers contributed **9,625 hours** of infection prevention service for a value of **\$273,928**.

VOLUNTEER ON-BOARDING

VA MRC **approved 8,408 applications** and volunteers attended a statewide virtual COVID-19 orientation. VA MRC coordination team delivered 2,842 badges and conducted 5,290 background investigations. This COVID-19 membership campaign resulted in a record breaking **66% increase of deployable volunteers within 120 days**.
