Candida auris **Testing**

Candida auris (C. auris for short) is a drug-resistant germ (fungus) that can spread in healthcare facilities.



Why is C. auris a special concern?


C. auris can cause life threatening infections and only a few medicines may be able to treat the infection. There has been an increase in C. auris in our community.

How to know if you have C. auris You need a lab test to confirm if you have C. auris

- C. auris can make you very sick or you can have it without any symptoms, that is called colonization.
- You can spread *C. auris* even without symptoms.

Why are we testing for *C. auris?*

1. If you have C. auris you may need different medicines to treat an infection*.



2. If you have C. auris it can spread to others, and they might become sick.
