Competency Statement	Method of Validation
Demonstrates proper technique for putting on (donning) and taking off (doffing) personal protective equipment (PPE). Verbalizes knowledge of how PPE helps prevent healthcare-associated infections. Verbalizes knowledge of how to select appropriate PPE based on Standard Precautions and Transmission-Based Precautions.	D = Demonstrate V = Verbalize

Critical Behaviors for Competency

- Verbalize knowledge of the importance of appropriate use of personal protective equipment in preventing healthcare-associated infections.
- Verbalize knowledge of how to select appropriate PPE based on Standard Precautions and Transmission-Based Precautions.
- Demonstrate proper donning and doffing technique using the Personal Protective Equipment Competency Validation/Audit Tool.
- Frequency: Suggested on hire, as an ongoing yearly competency, as needed if unit compliance is below %, and if lapses in PPE use contributed to a serious safety event.
