



HEY PARENTS!

DO YOU KNOW ABOUT TEST TO STAY (TTS)?

Test to Stay is a program in which close contacts of individuals with COVID-19 are allowed to remain in the classroom if they continue to test negative after the exposure, rather than quarantining at home.

TTS is an alternative to traditional at-home quarantine to minimize the impact of quarantine and student absences.

WHEN SCHOOLS IMPLEMENT TTS WITH OTHER PREVENTION STRATEGIES, THEY CAN:



Allow students in quarantine to safely continue in-person learning



Reduce the risk of further transmission



Detect and isolate new cases of COVID-19



Protect Students, Teachers, and Staff from COVID-19

YOUR CHILD MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR TTS IF THEY:



Are a close contact of someone with COVID-19



Do not have any symptoms of COVID-19 (aka asymptomatic)



Are not up to date on COVID-19 vaccines



Are willing and able to wear a mask



Submit a consent form signed by a parent/guardian.

YOUR CHILD IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN TTS IF:

- They have symptoms of COVID-19, test positive for COVID-19, or cannot wear a mask.
- They are up to date on COVID-19 vaccines, or have had COVID-19 in the last three months.
