

Weekly ED and Urgent Care Visits for Influenza-Like Illness, VA, 9/12/21 – 9/17/22





*Compared to last week:

- Cases decreased to 84.7 (7-day MA) per day (-34.3%)
- Hospitalizations decreased to 599 (7-day MA) per day (-9.2%)
- 7-day moving average of new deaths is 14
