In Re: Gerald Abbott

ORDER

On January 28, 1998, Mr. Abbott came to be heard on his appeal of the denial of his application for an onsite sewage disposal system construction permit for a system to serve an existing four-bedroom house, an existing oyster house, and a new marina on a 2.9 acre parcel on Carter Cove in Lancaster County. Mr. Abbott further appealed the Commissioner's denial of variances from the Sewage Handling and Disposal Regulations.

After a portion of Mr. Abbott's evidence had been heard, and at the conclusion of the lunch break, Mr. Abbott and the Department notified the Board that the dispute had been settled and that the Department is prepared to issue the permit in one of two forms, each of which is acceptable to Mr. Abbott. On that basis, the appeal will be removed from the docket. The Board requests a status report from the Department at its next meeting.
