### Newly Granted FDA EUA for Paxlovid

- The FDA granted an EUA for the Pfizer product, Paxlovid (nirmatrelvir and ritonavir), on 12/22/2021
- Paxlovid is an oral antiviral authorized for the treatment of active mild-to-moderate COVID-19 in patients 12 years of age and older that are at high risk for progression to severe COVID-19

### Newly Granted FDA EUA for Molnupiravir

- The FDA granted an EUA for the Merck product, Molnupiravir, on 12/23/2021
- Molnupiravir is an oral antiviral authorized for the treatment of active mild-to-moderate COVID-19 in patients 18 years of age and older who are at high risk for progression to severe COVID-19

### Continued Availability of BAM/ETE and REGEN-COV

- VDH would like to clarify that the Delta variant is still a variant of concern in the United States and, therefore, BAM/ETE and REGEN-COV are still available for order
- HHS had initially made an announcement that they would no longer be providing BAM/ETE or Regen-COV, that is **no longer the case**, additional information will be provided as we learn more from our federal partners
