

## **2023-2024** Checklist For Newly Enrolled Students



Whether your child is starting as a kindergartener or transferring from another school, you'll need to follow certain steps.

Use this checklist as a guide – and be sure to talk to your school for more details.

	Make sure your student is enrolled in school! 	Visit your child's healthcare provider for an exam and immunizations to complete school entrance and sports physical forms.  ALL STUDENTS: For these forms to be complete, your child will need these immunizations (or a completed religious exemption certificate):  Kindergarten: 4 doses of DTaP, 4 doses of Polio, 2 Doses of Hepatitis A, 3 doses of Hepatitis B, 2 doses of MMR, 2 Doses of Varicella  Grade 7: Tdap, HPV*, Meningococcal  Grade 12: Meningococcal  *Note: parents or guardians may opt for their child not to receive the HPV vaccine. 	Visit a dentist for a back-to-school checkup.  Note: If your family is insured through Medicaid, both children and adults are now covered for dental care in Virginia.  Do an emotional wellness check.
