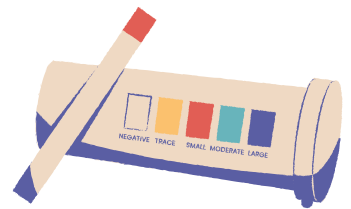

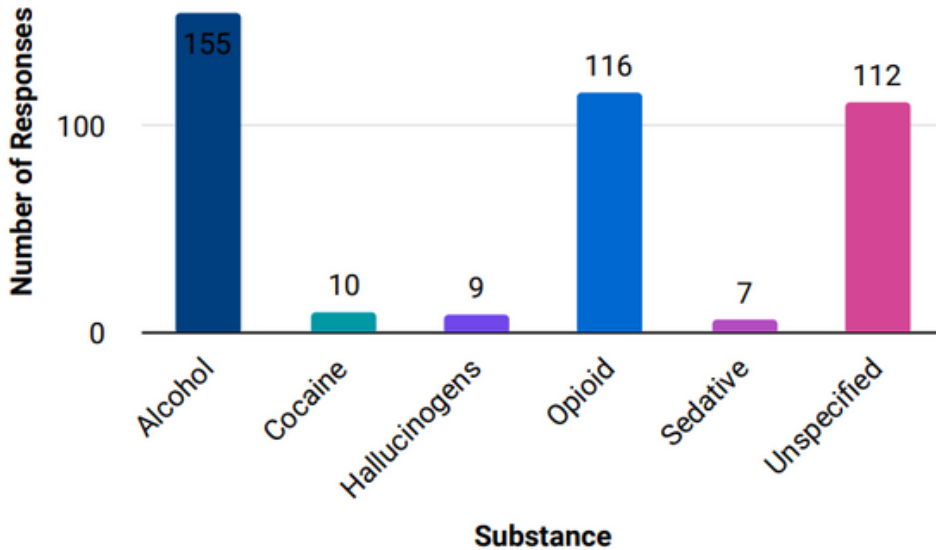

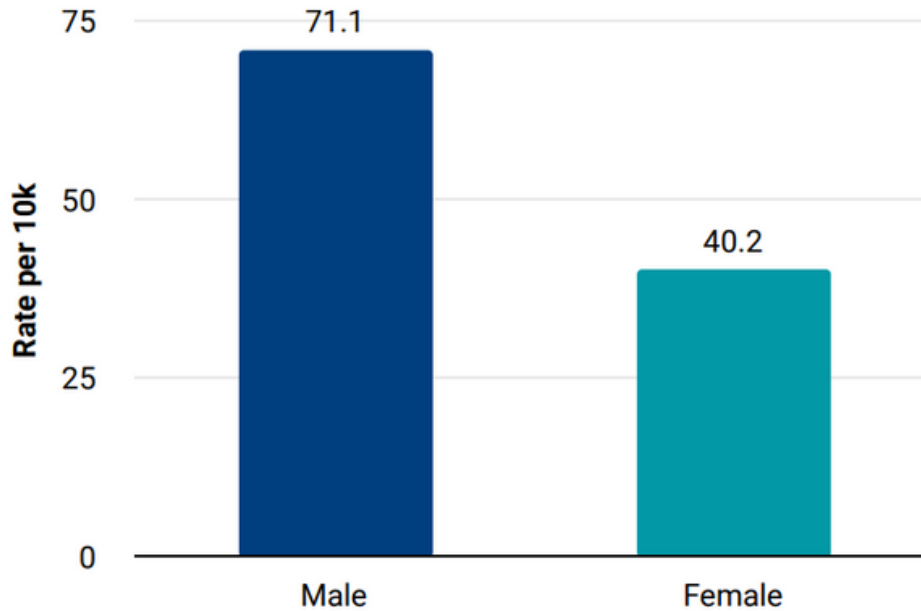

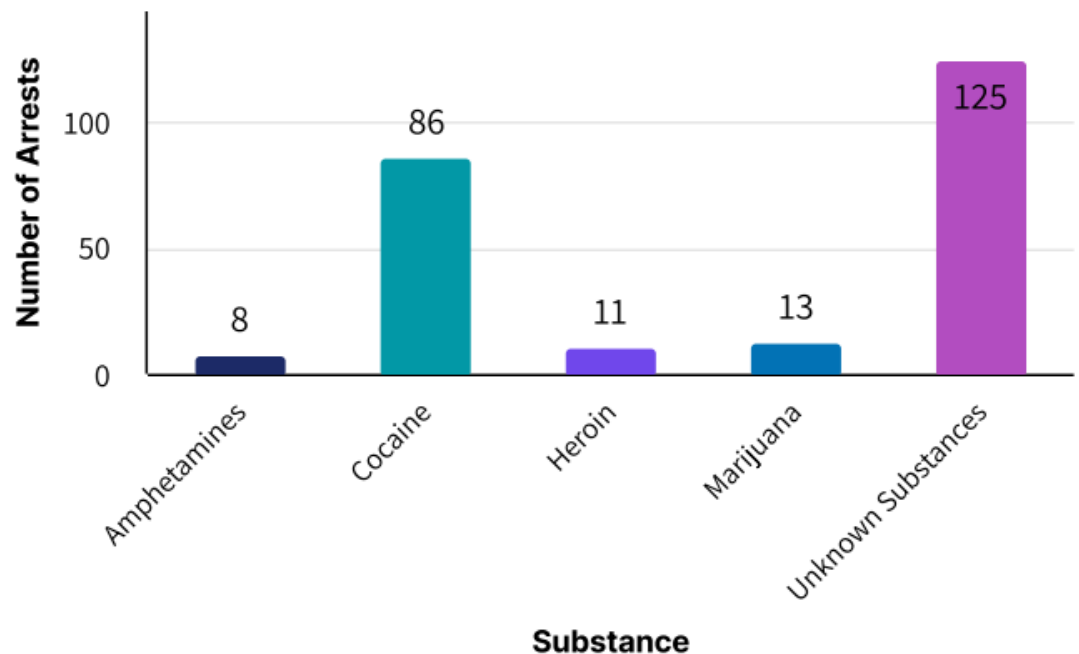

Substance Related Arrests January 2023- December 2023

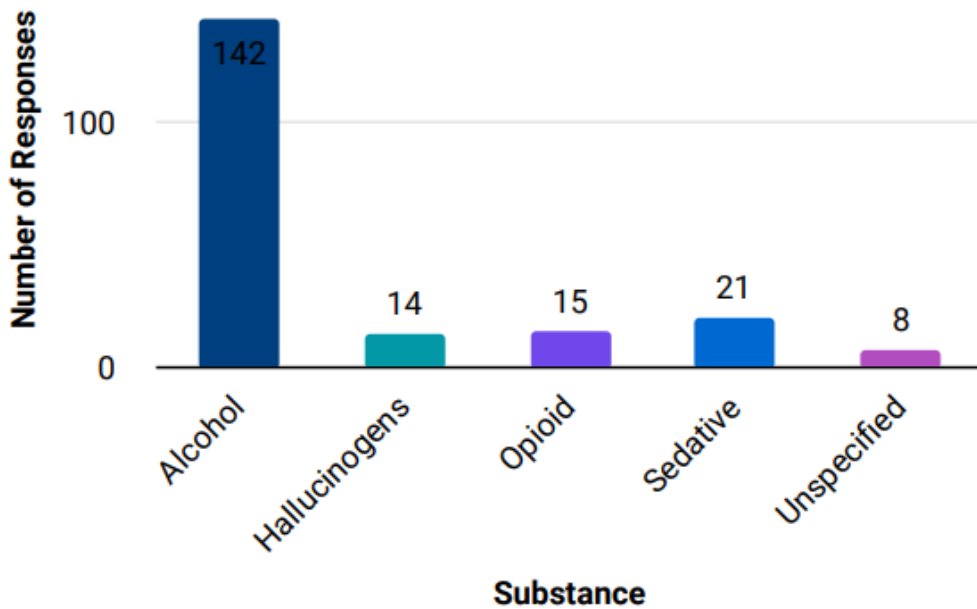

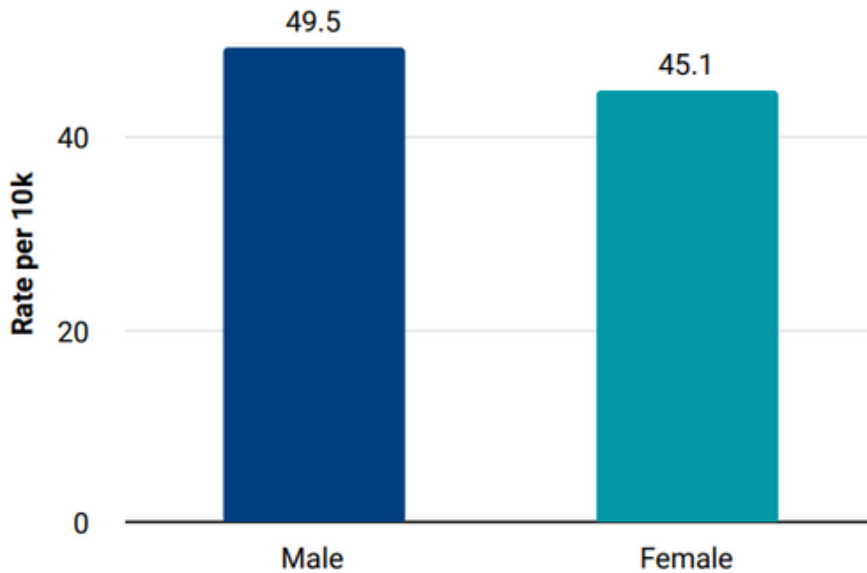

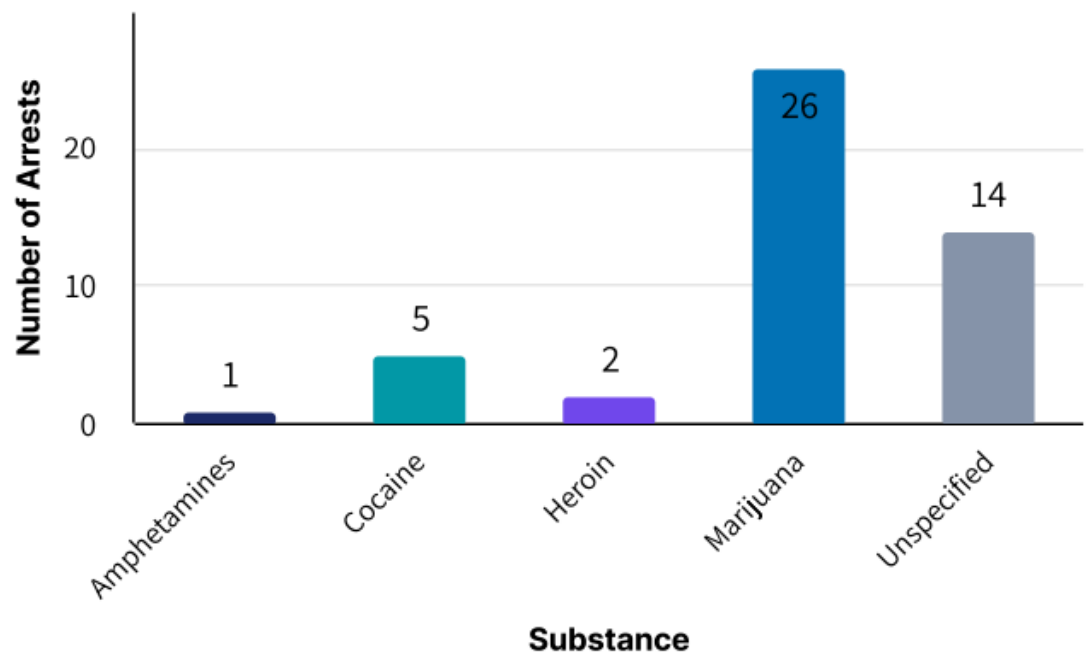

Substance Related Arrests January 2023- December 2023

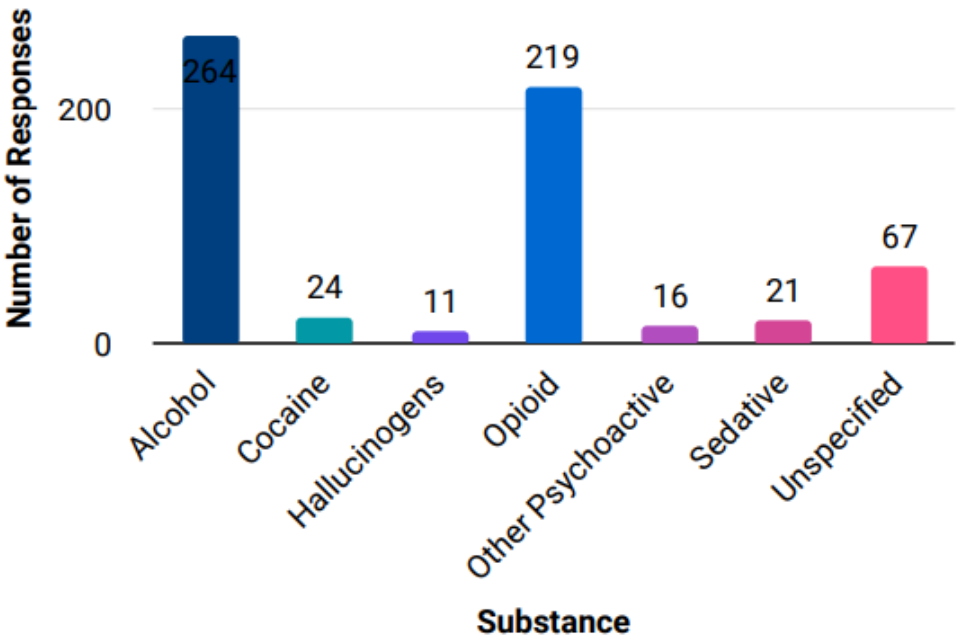

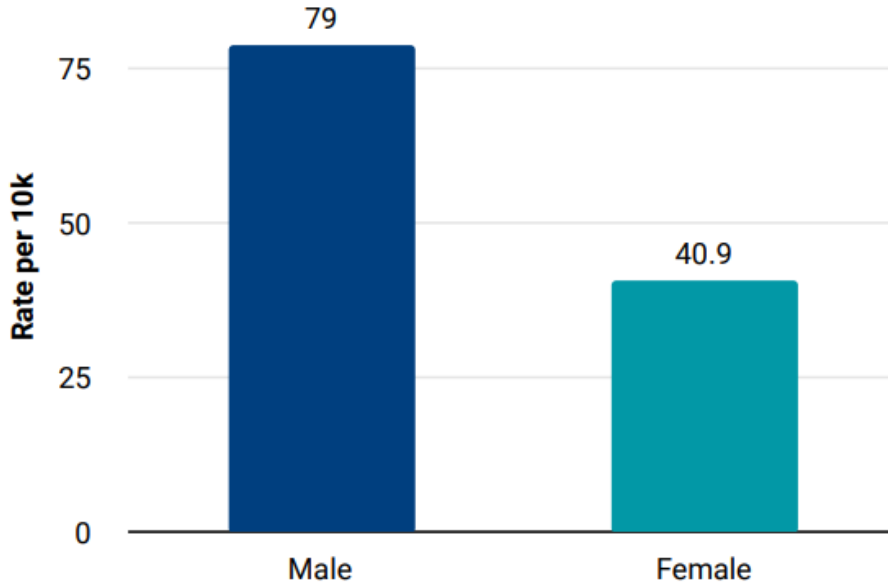

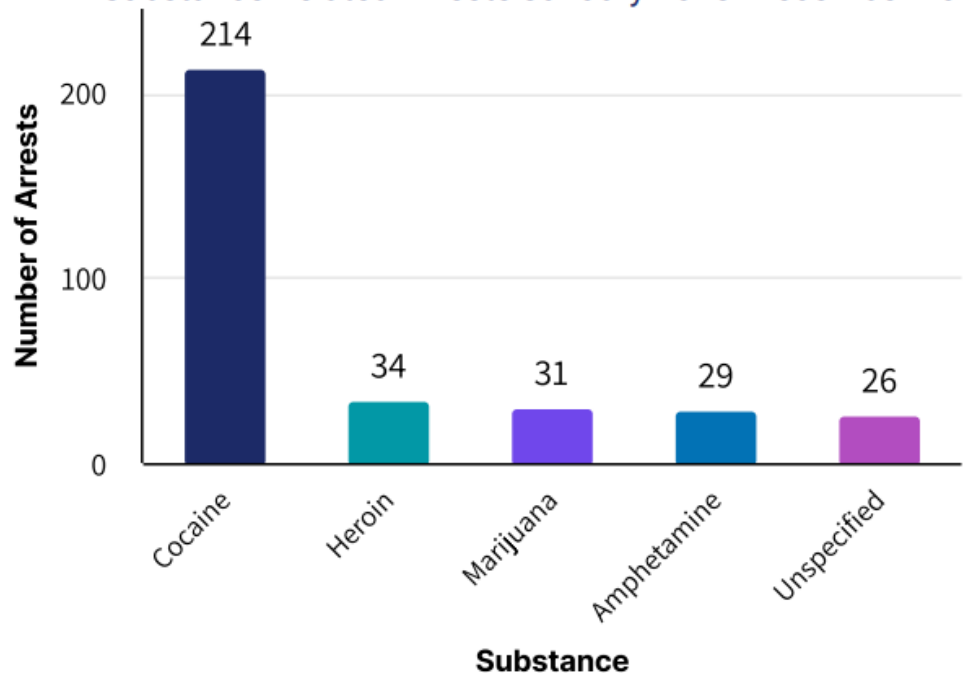

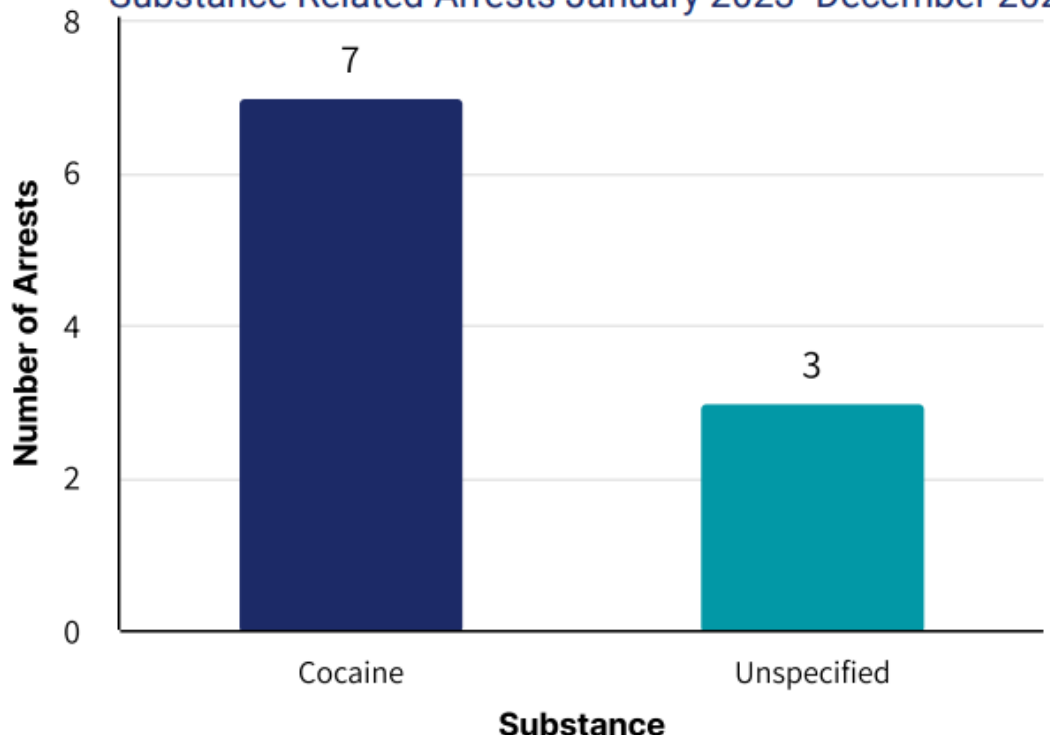

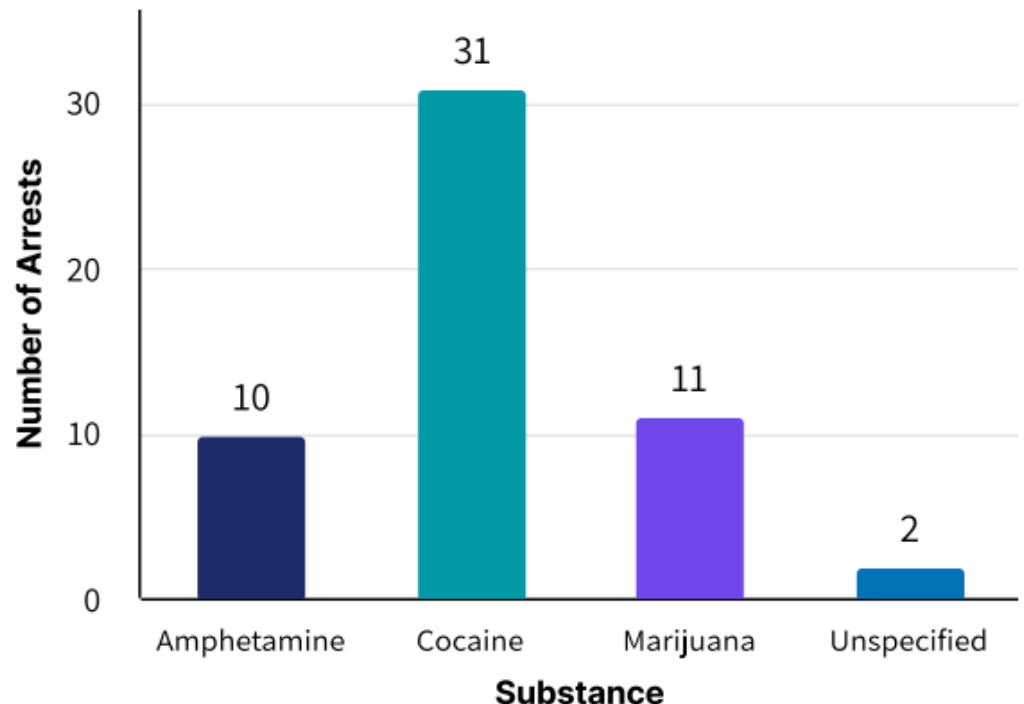

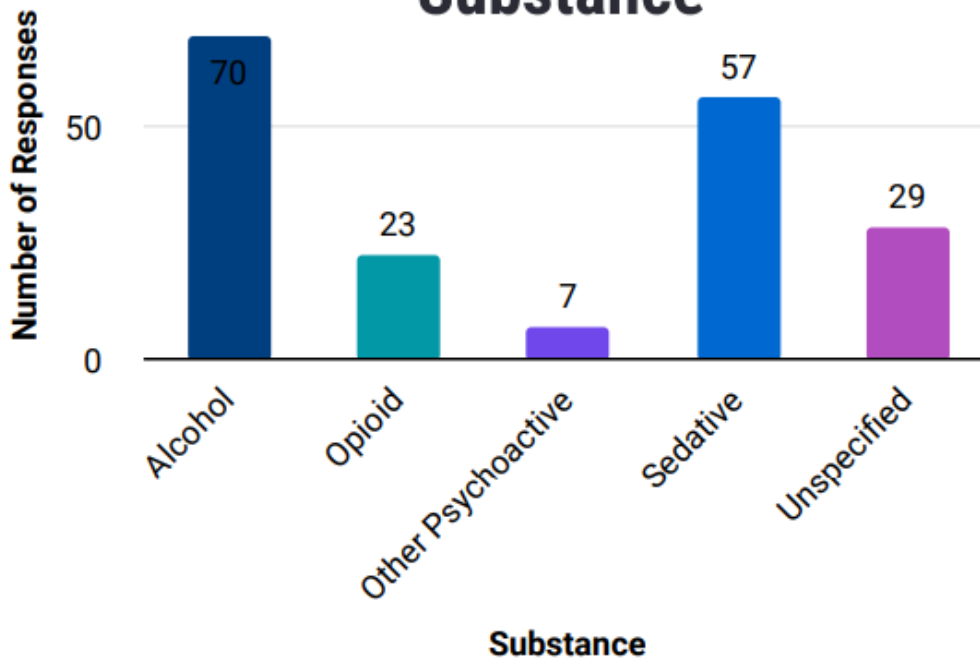

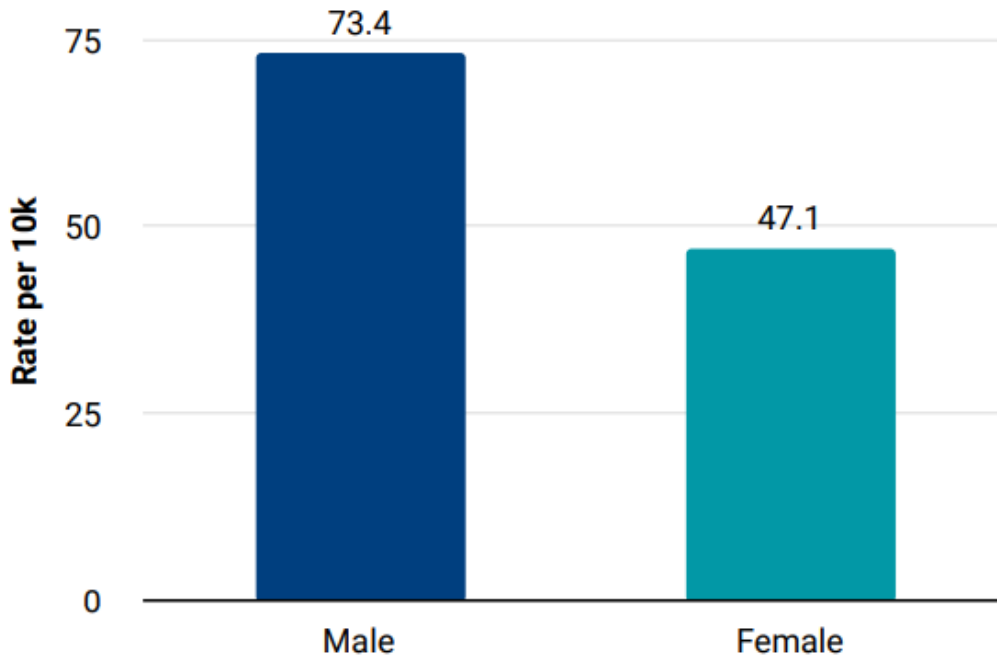

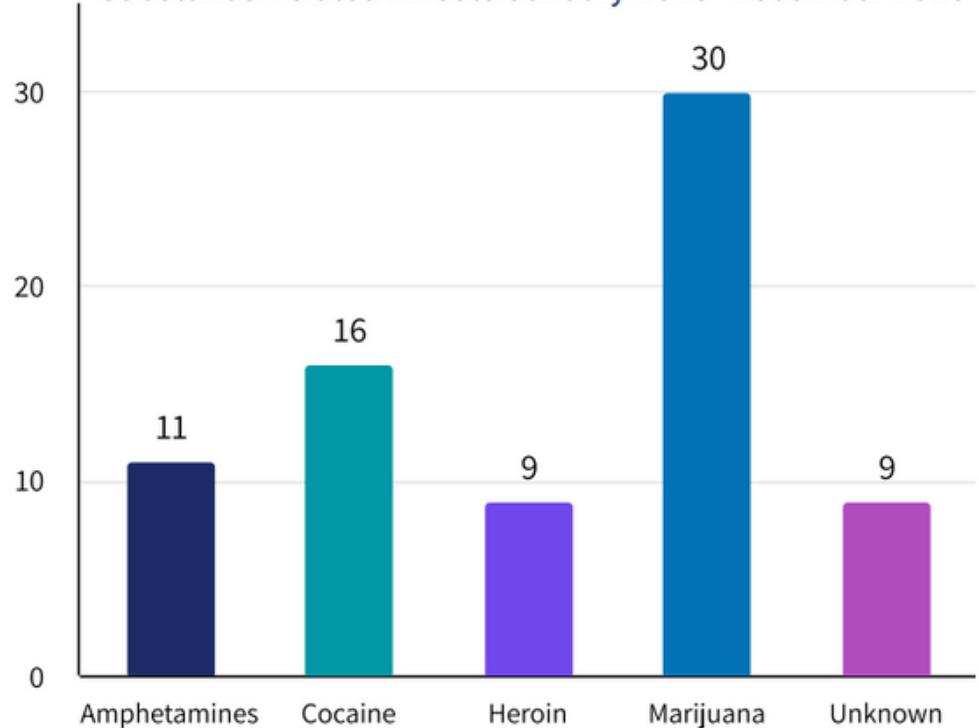
