# REPORT INFORMATION

This report provides an overview of data for the year 2024 on Project LEAD, the Hampton & Peninsula Health District's (HPHD) first substance use and opioid response program, which launched in January 2023. In addition, it includes key substance use data from 2024 for the Cities of Hampton, Newport News, Poquoson, and Williamsburg, as well as the Counties of James City and York.

The goal of this report is to equip community partners with relevant data to better understand substance use disorder in the Greater Peninsula Region and to guide resource deployment where it is most needed. All included data has been authorized for release by its respective sources, with citations available on the last page; some data may be suppressed due to confidentiality concerns. We hope this report serves as a valuable tool in ongoing efforts to combat the opioid epidemic and support those affected.

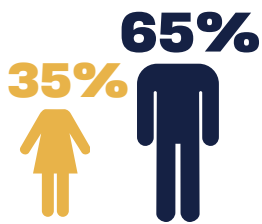

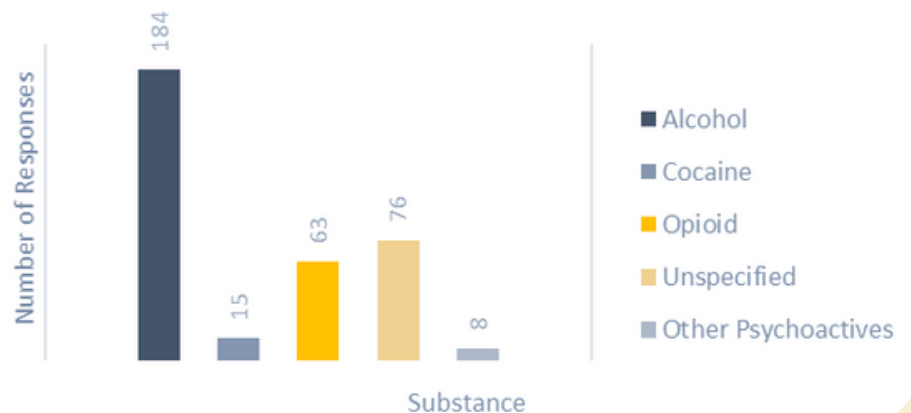

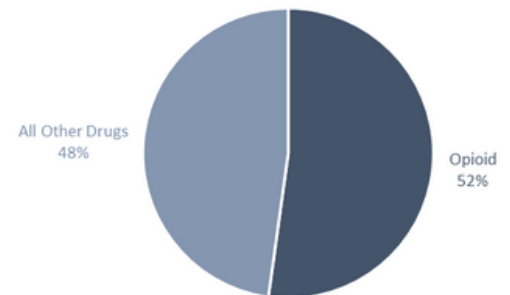

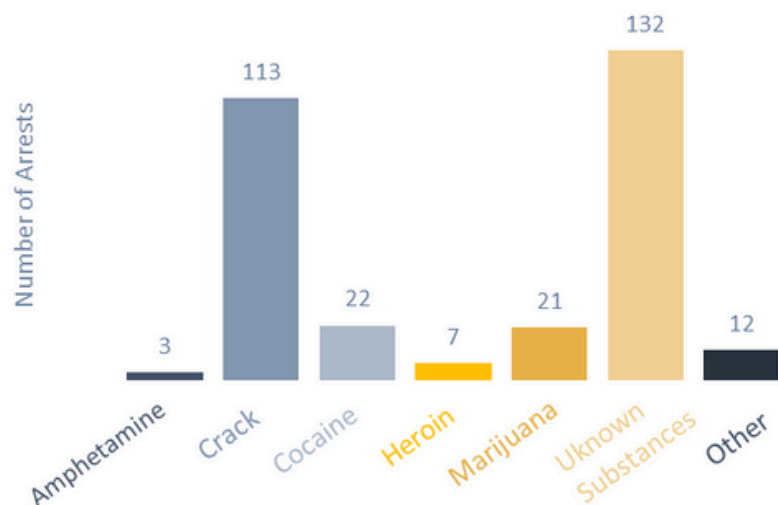

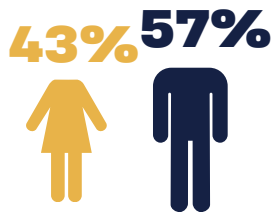

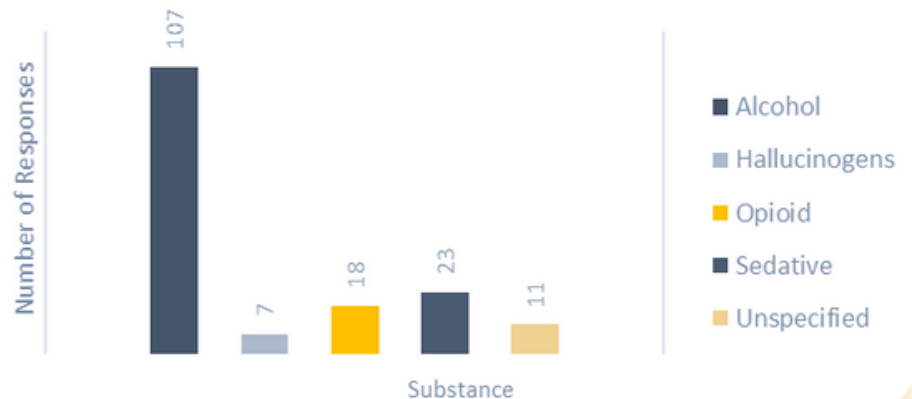

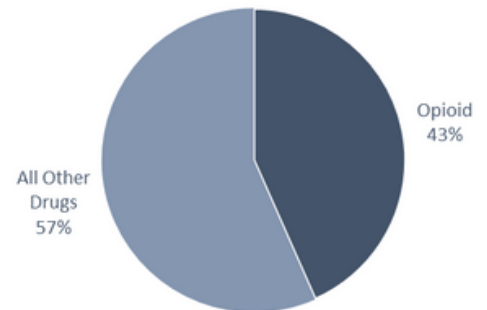

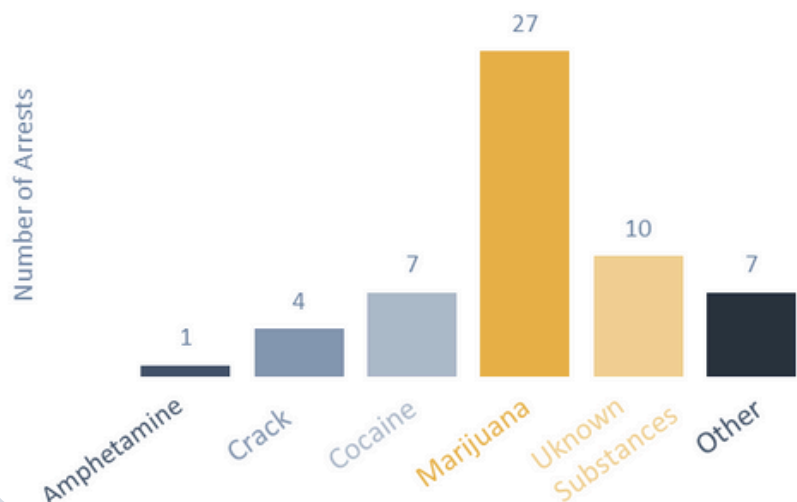

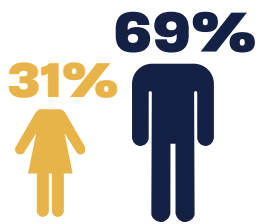

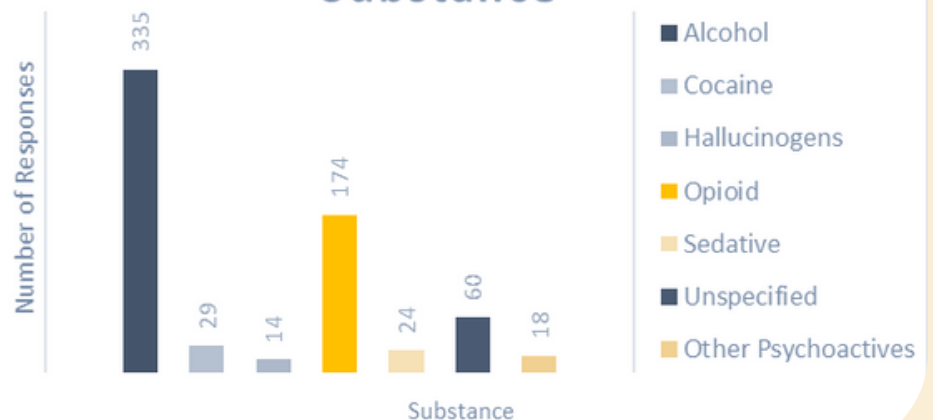

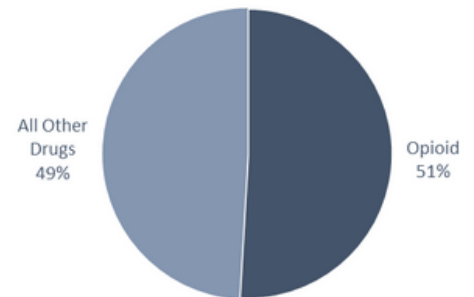

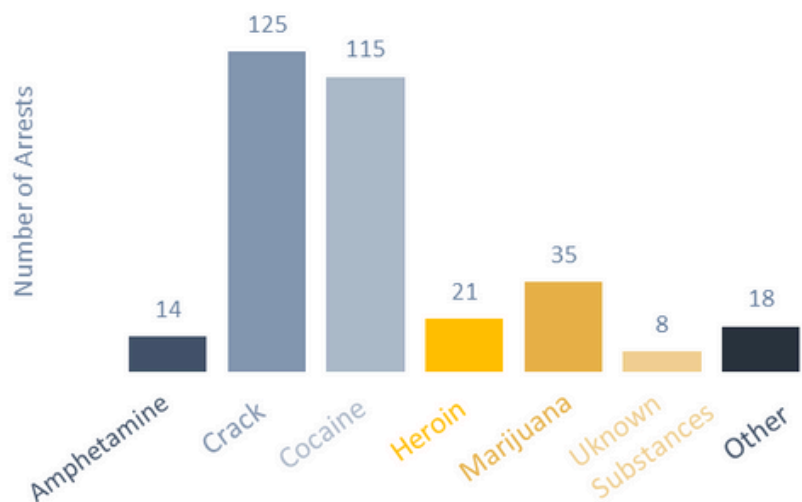

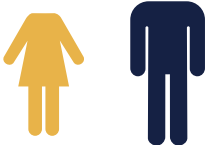

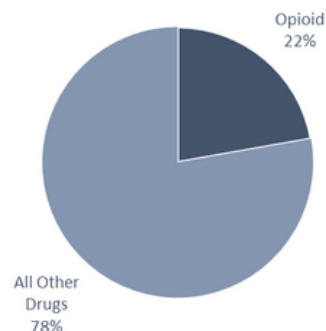

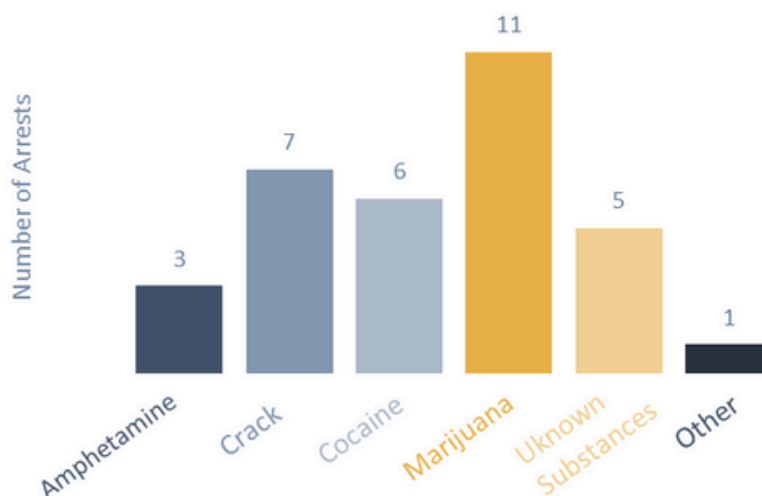

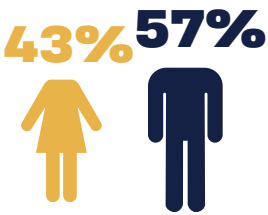

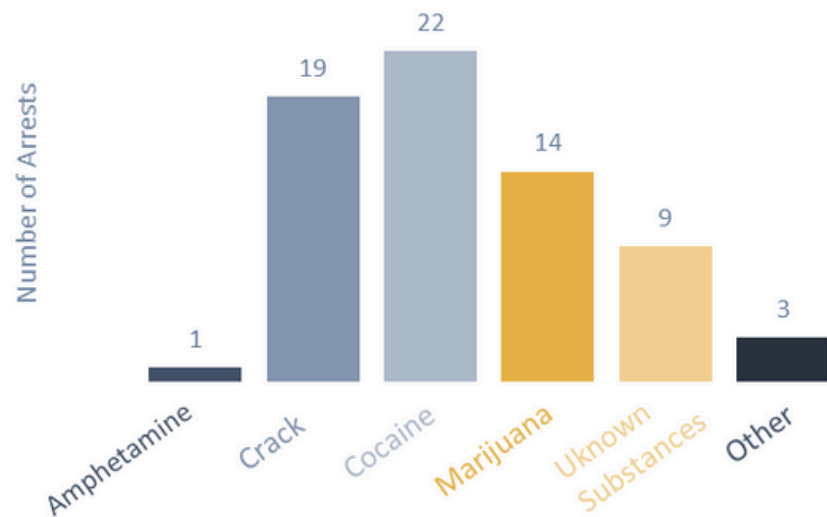

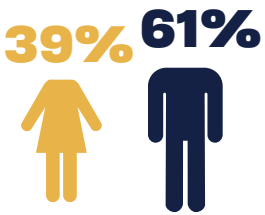

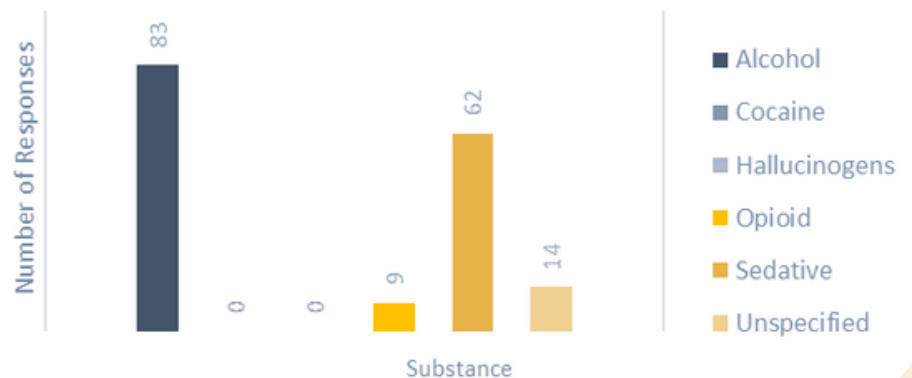

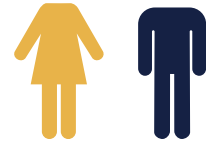

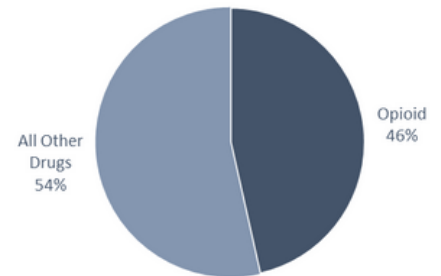

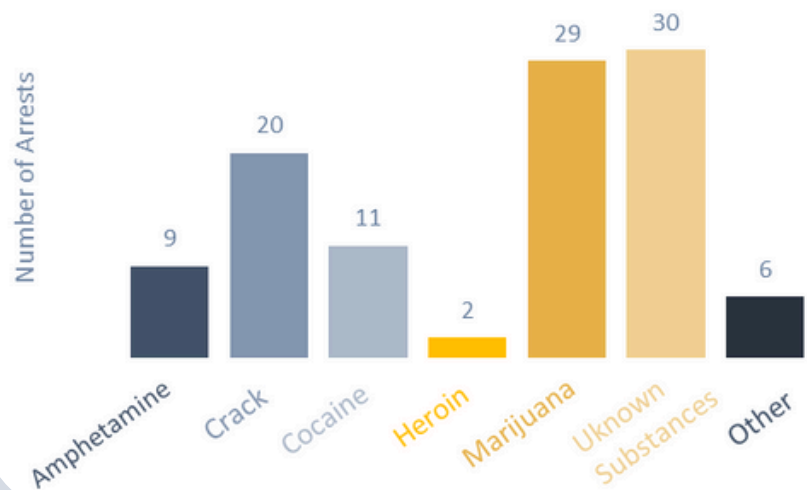
