WHAT ARE THE SYMPTOMS?

Rash

Can look like pimples or blisters. Might develop on one part of the body or on many parts of the body. The rash may be painful.

OTHER POSSIBLE SYMPTOMS



Fever



Headache



Muscle / Back Aches



Swollen Lymph Nodes



Chills



Tiredness
