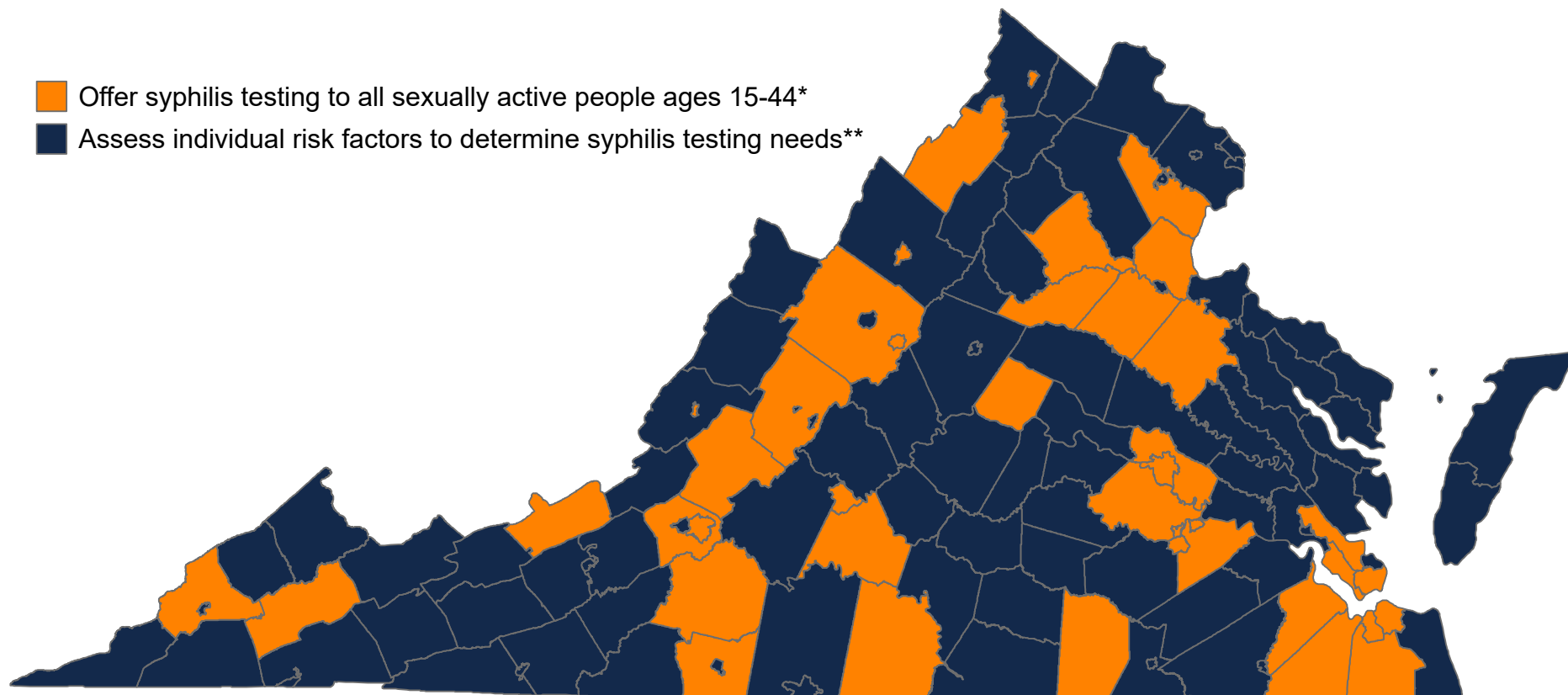


# 2023 Virginia Syphilis Screening Guidelines by County/City



\* In counties/cities where the rate of primary & secondary syphilis among women aged 15-44 years was greater than 4.6 per 100,000 in 2023, providers should offer syphilis testing to all sexually active people aged 15-44 years.

\*\* In counties/cities where the rate of primary & secondary syphilis among women aged 15-44 years was less than or equal to 4.6 per 100,000 in 2023, providers should continue to assess individual risk factors to determine testing needs as outlined in the CDC [screening guidelines](#).
