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# Welcome to Symposium!

This is your guide to the EMS Symposium. Here you will find your course locations, hotel floor plans and hotel information, a guide to your favorite events, frequently asked questions and much more. #### Important Information & Policies

The quality of EMS education and your safety while attending the Virginia EMS Symposium are of utmost concern to OEMS. The following Symposium requirements will be strictly enforced:

- A photo identification may be requested of you when you register.
- Only one registration package per person will be allowed.
- You will not be allowed in a class without an official 2021 Symposium name badge. Your 2021 Symposium name badge must be worn at all times.
- No one will be admitted to a class once the class has begun and the doors are shut.
- Please be courteous to others no babies or children are allowed in a class.

• Smoking is only allowed in designated areas.

• You must turn off your cell phones and pagers or set them on vibrate. Use of electronic devices for anything other than taking notes is strictly prohibited.

• Continuing Education (CE) for the 2021 Symposium will be recorded by scanning the barcode on your name badge. The CE will appear within 24 hours of attendance at the class. Do not load up on food and/or take it to friends or family members back in your room. No food or drinks will be allowed in the elevators or beyond the convention center.

• The Governor's EMS Awards ceremony will include banquet-style seating and a plated dinner will be served. Seating will be set for social distancing so please don't move chairs.

• Please review your entire course schedule and pre-locate your classes. Account for refreshment time and travel time in between classes or different locations. Be patient, courteous, friendly and out-going. The Virginia EMS Symposium can offer you the best opportunity you have as an EMS provider to network with other EMS providers from across the state and nation, and to learn about different EMS systems. #### Symposium Parking & Transportation

Free parking is available for Symposium registrants at Harbor Park baseball stadium. If you park at Harbor Park you must get a permit from the parking permit table on the 3rd floor in the Marriott. Parking at Harbor Park during Symposium will only be available in Lot D from Tuesday, Nov. 2 at 3:00 p.m. - Sunday, Nov. 7 at noon. A Symposium marked shuttle bus will make stops at Harbor Park, the corner of Martins Lane and E. Main Street (for Marriott and Hilton hotels) and the Sheraton hotel.

#### **Frequently Asked Questions**

1. Why are the classrooms so cold or hot? The temperatures in the rooms can vary. Please wear comfortable clothes in layers so you can easily adjust to the temperature. If the temperature in a room is extreme and the majority of people in the class are uncomfortable, ask your room host to see if the hotel can adjust it.

2. Can we have handouts for every class? Every instructor is asked to provide handouts, but some choose not to.

3. Why are there not enough chairs for the class? Classroom size and chairs are determined by the number of providers who **register** for each class. This is why people are not allowed to attend classes that they are not registered for.

4. Can we get discounted parking fees in the parking deck across from the hotel? The parking deck is regulated by the City of Norfolk which does not offer a discount. There is free parking available to attendees at the Harbor Park baseball stadium.

5. Why not hold the Virginia EMS Symposium in other locations? OEMS sought a Request for Proposals and bids from facilities and localities throughout the Commonwealth. Through this competitive negotiation process a contract through November 2021 was awarded to

# **COVID-19 Safety Guidelines**

Our goal is to host this event in the safest way possible by following the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and state guidelines. Your adherence to the guidelines listed below is critical for the safety and success of this event.

# • Proof of vaccination status OR a negative COVID-19 test result is required to attend this event.

Please be prepared to submit your COVID-19 vaccination card OR proof of a negative COVID-19 test that has been taken no more than ten (10) days before the start of this event date (Nov. 3, 2021.) This will be required for all registrants and vendors to attend. Anyone who is unable to provide this information will have their symposium registration cancelled.

• Masks are required to be worn by all event participants for the duration of this event. This includes all indoor spaces, classrooms, vendor hall, during special events and in any common areas, unless it is a designated eating area.

Masks shall be worn properly, to completely cover the nose and mouth.

If you do not have a mask, one will be provided to you at symposium registration check in on the third floor of the Marriott hotel. Hand sanitizer will also be provided at check in for your use.

If you refuse to wear your mask you will be asked to leave and your symposium registration will be revoked.

• All event attendees must maintain social distance when in the classroom, vendor hall, during special events and in common areas of the symposium event space, which includes all three hotels that are hosting this event (the Marriott, Hilton and Sheraton.)


# Hotel Floor Maps The Norfolk Waterside Marriott


# Hotel Floor Maps The Sheraton Norfolk Waterside
