Background Unit Update</p> <p>i. FieldPrint – January 1, 2020 – Process Review</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Fingerprint submission process 2. Paper card request submission process 3. Fee’s – who pays and who doesn’t – Non-certified vs Certified Budget does not allow OEMS to pay for Non-affiliated members State contract must be followed by the Vendor <p>Cost of Fingerprints needs to get reduced by possibly screening who actually gets fingerprinted for agencies. Also needs education as to when provider needs to be fingerprinted and articulated that personal info is not accessible to fieldprint location employees.</p> <p>Plan to do away with paper process by this summer and results are to be directly entered into provider portal and also directly into the agency portal.</p> <p>OEMS no longer supports a specific DICO program – Agency is responsible to have formal DICO training. OSHA will handle any issues. OEMS will only require proof of DICO training.</p> <p>ACE division offers DICO training refresher and in the future will provide an 8 hr training course.</p>
