Preventing House Heating Fires

- Heating fires were the second leading cause of home fires in 2021.
- Plug space heaters into an outlet and ensure no damage to the cord.
- Keep flammable objects at least three feet away from any heat source.
- Never use an oven to heat your home.
- Have regular maintenance performed on chimneys and other heating equipment.
