What this ECHO will focus on

This ECHO will engage and instruct the modern EMS workforce and other healthcare team members in acute and non-acute best care practices for their local communities. This includes a focus on rural outreach and telemedicine implementation. Providers will gain knowledge of primary and secondary prevention of acute and chronic diseases and conditions.

Learning Objectives/Outcomes
