

VDH-OEMS Substance Use Case Definition

Inclusion Criteria

All persons with a provider primary impression code (eSituation.11) attributable to drugs with potential for abuse and dependence, including:

F12.1 - F12.9	Cannabis-related disorders

F15.0 - F15.9	Other stimulant-related disorders
F16.0 - F16.9	Hallucinogen-related disorders
F18 – F18.9	Inhalant-related disorders

O99.32	Drug use complicating pregnancy, childbirth, and the puerperium
P04.4	Newborn (suspected to be) affected by maternal use of drugs of addiction

T40.0 - T40.9	Poisoning by narcotics and psychodysleptics (hallucinogens)
T42.3	Poisoning by barbiturates
T42.4	Poisoning by benzodiazepines
T42.6	Poisoning by other antiepileptic and sedative-hypnotic drugs
T42.7	Poisoning by unspecified antiepileptic and sedative-hypnotic drugs
T43.6	Poisoning by psychostimulants

*The listed code may be an abbreviation of the full ICD-10-CM code. Codes are comprised of between 4 and 7 characters. Codes are included based on the Council for State and Territorial Epidemiologists' (CSTE) [Recommended Substance Use Surveillance Indicators](#), with modifications.

Exclusion Criteria

For all primary impressions listed, the following exclusions apply:

- Adverse effects
- Underdosing
- Encounters due to sequela
- Substances that cause adverse effects in therapeutic use
- Effects of unknown drugs with unspecified potential for abuse and dependence (e.g., “poisoning by other drugs, medicaments, and biological substances”)
